Although second to Sheaves in the 10 mile championship, Gainsford's time beat the previous Australasian record by 19 seconds. This was a very fine performance in a race which included most of Australia's best distance runners with the exception of Kohlman (Vic).

In the Manly event Gainsford again finished second to Sheaves after a most exciting finish, only being beaten by 0.5 seconds. His time was 12.5 secs faster than the previous record.
