39TH ANNUAL REPORT AND BALANCE SHEET

PRESENTED TO MEMBERS AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE ELECTRICITY HOUSE, HURSTVILLE ON PRIDAY 25th MAY, 1962.

Gentlemen.

The 41st Annual Report and Balance Shoot of your Club is presented to you tonight and it would be quite safe to say that our achievements during the past 12 months were better than the previous year.

For years now it has been agreed unanimously that Albert Thomas has been our best athlete and the story is still the same this year but we do feel that on the horizon we have David Chisholm who must surely take the place of Albert when he retires or when his form deteriorates as it must do sooner or later.

Albert this year achieved a grand embition when he recently won the One Mile Championship of Australia in 4 min. 6.9 secs. and in doing so was only the second New South Welshman to win this event since the championships commenced in 1893.

Albert also finished 2nd in Australian 5 mile track title to Dave Power and he gained 2nd place to Bob Vagg in the 10,000 metres Australian Cross Country Championship at Centennial Park in the most appalling weather that could be recalled in this event.

He also had two trips to New Zealand during the year and at Auckland on the 16th December 1961 he defeated Barry Mages over 3 miles in 15 min. 37 secs.

During the Cross Country Season he finished 2nd in the 10,000 metres C.C.C., 2nd in the 10 Mile Championship and 3rd in the State 15 Mile.

Albert completed another grand year when he won the State Mile title for the 4th year in succession and was 3rd in both the 3 and 6 Mile events.

One of the outstanding features of the year was the grand improvement shown by David Chisholm and his performances in the 10,000 metres Australian C.C.C. and the 3000 metres Australian Steeplechase gladdened the hearts of all his clubmates and friends.

His 3rd place in the 10,000 metres Australian C.C.C. in 35 min. 59 secs. only 10 seconds behind Albert Thomas and in front of David Power is the best performance of his career and in time he must surely win an Australian title either during the distance or track seasons. Another grand performance by David was his 3rd place in the 3000 metres Steeplechase

Championship of Australia and his time of 9 min. 8 secs. would have won the event for the past 2 years.

David also gained 3rd place in the State 10,000 metres C.C.C. and ran 4 min. 12 secs. for the Mile at Hurstville Oval and he can be extremely pleased with his performances for his first season in the senior ranks.

Our senior distance runners did just a little better than the previous year gaining 3rd place in the teams races for the State 10,300 metres, 10 mile and 2nd in the Marathon. Senior athletes also gained 3rd place in the 4 x 5 Mile State Relay.

Our young distance runners again did very well.

Malcolm Rooke running extremely well to win the State
Junior 5000 Metres and with his Clubmates Klaus Stelter,
Geoff Elphinston and Ross Proud they also won the Teams
title. Malcolm Rooke also ran brilliantly during the
track season winning the State 1500 metres Steeplechase
- 4 min. 37 secs.; also the State 2 Mile 9 min. 22 secs.
and 2nd in the State Mile in 4 min. 23 secs. Grand prospoets are ahead for this splendid young athlete.

John Lee ran well to gain 2nd place in the State 3000 metros Sub Junior title and he was also a member of the winning relay team for the State 4 x 1 Mile. Our Junior team ran magnificently to win the State Junior 4 x 2 Mile relay by more than 2 minutes. Our Juveniles gained 2nd place in State teams 1500 metros and were a close 3rd in the State relay 4 x 2 Mile.

The 1960/61 track season has been our best for some years and while we did not win any grade competitions during interclub we did perform very creditably gaining 4th place in A Grade, 3rd in C Grade, 3rd in D Grade, 3rd in E Grade and 4th in under 16 Grade.

The St. George team of A. Thomas, D. Wilson, F. Thornton and D. Chisholm ran extremely well to win the State 4 x 880 relay in 7 min. 49 secs. but practically the same team was unexpectedly beaten into 2nd place in the State 4 x 1 M ile relay.

We are very pleased to have Dennis Tipping (Rome Olympic Games Representative 1960) in our ranks and he gained 3rd place in both State 100 yards and 220 yards titles. Dennis looks forward to reproducing his best form next season.

Fleming Barchmann's 2nd place in the Pole Vault at 12 feet was most pleasing and equal to the best yet recorded by a St. George athlete. Ian Sharpe is our most promising Long Jumper since Basil Dickinson and his jumping performances during the season were most gratifying. Neil Meredith is the best High Jumper ever to join St. George and at different times he jumped 6.51m 6.2m and 6.3m.

St. George did exceptionally well to provide 7 athletes for the Australian Track & Field Championships namely A. Thomas, D. Chisholm, F. Barchmann, I Sharpe, D. Tipping, D. Wilson and N. Meredith and in the N.S.W. v. Victoria Match those who represented were F. Thornton, D. Chisholm, D. Wilson, F. Barchmann, N. Meredith, I Sharpe, D. Tipping while A. Thomas was not available.

Club membership has decreased from 190 to 148 and this is a matter that needs immediate attention. Attendances at Hurstville Oval were quite good prior to Christmas, but as usual fell away in the New Year, although attendances for the last 3 or 4 evenings were a good bit better than last year.

Congratulations once again to Fred Larcombe for organising the Annual Schoolboy Championships which were held at Kogarah Jubilee Oval on Saturday 16th September 1961 under ideal conditions. Entries were well up to standard and while thanking Fred for another grand job we also remember his band of fellow teachers who contribute so much to this meeting year after year.

A word of warning to most of our athletes and that is in regard to wearing of the correct club costume at all Club, Open and Championship Meetings. In recent years Club members in many instances have shown scant respect for their Club costume, yet in the past St. George year after year were adjudged the best dressed athletes in the Association. Our leading athletes should set an example to be followed by all members. It is not fair to your Club or its supporters to see athletes competing in incorrect costume. We look forward from tonight to a big improvement in this regard.
