42nd ANNUAL REPORT AND BALANCE SHEET

PRESENTED TO MEMBERS AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE ELECTRICITY HOUSE, HURSTVILLE ON FRIDAY 10th MAY 1963.

Gentlemen,

The 42nd Annual Report and Balance Shoet of your Club is presented to you tonight and it would appear that out achievements for the past 12 months equalled those of the previous year, although in some instances individual performances have been better.

Albert Thomas once again proved himself to be our best athlete.

Probably his best run during the year was his brillian 3m.59.8s. for the Mile in the MSW v Victoria Match. Albert is the only athlete ever to break 4 mins in NSW and he has now done this on 2 occasions as he ran 3m. 58.8s on the Sydney Sports Ground in 1960.

Another brilliant performance was his 13m. 21.6s. for the 3 mile at the C & BEG trials when he reduced his own Australian record from 13m. 26s. For the 2nd year in succession he won the Australian Mile Title at Adelaide and he won the State Mile in 4m. 1s.and 3 Mile in 13m. 37.2s.

Albert during the distance Season gained 2nd place in the State 10 mile and 10,000 Metres and won the Club Marathon in the good time of 2 hrs. 42.31 secs.

New member Len Chinnery performed brilliantly with the Discus and Shot and his best throw with the discus was 165'.42" and 51'.62" for the Shot both performances were made at the C & BEG trials.

One of the most promising athletes ever to join our Club is Neil Meredith who as a Junior cleared 6.44" in the High Jump and a week later did 6.7" when he gained 2nd place in the State Title.

Another brilliant young athlete is Greg Glynn who as a Junior gained 4th place in the Australian Senior title with a Javelin throw of 213'.4" the best ever recorded by a St. George athlete. He also won the State Junior title with a throw of 192'.1".

Mal Lutton with a throw of 131'.102" for the discus show distinct promise as he is still a Junior.

Other track athletes to do well were Jan Sharpe let State Long Jump, 3rd Australian Long Jump. Kevin Gowan 47*2" Hop Step & Jump best jump for the season or John Hancock 2nd State Sub Junior Hile 4m. 30.2s. (Club record).

The St.George team of D.Wilson, D.Chisholm
J. Duxbury and V. Bruce again won the State 4x880
title in the smart time of 7m. 51sees. but practically
the same team was unexpectedly beaten into 2nd place
in the State 4x1 mile relay.

Congratulations to these athletes in representing Australia. Albert after winning his Mile Heat in 4m. 2.2secs. (faster than the final) ran disappointingly in both the Mile and 3 Mile.

Our Senior distance athletes ran somewhat better than the previous year gaining 2nd place in the teams events for 10,000 metres and 10 mile while our Novice Team tied for 1st place in 5 mile Novice Cross-Country Championship. For the first time in many years our Juniors — sub Juniors and Juveniles failed to show up in the State events, but we hope this is only a temporary lapse.

In the State distance season relays, our teams did very well, the seniors being 3rd in the 4 x 5 mile, the Juniors Roote, Proud, McWilliams & Stelter easily won the 4 x 2 mile which the Sub-Juniors & Juveniles were only beaten by inches and 1 yard respectively in the 4 x 1 mile and 4 x 3 mile.

David Chisholm did not show the improvement expected of him but he was dogged by injury throughout the year and probably this year will be his best season

Congratulations to John Bowers on his excellent improvement.

The 1961/62 track season (Interclub) was not

4th place in "A" Grade the same as 1960/61. Our B Grade team was well down the list while E Grade again finished 3rd and the Juniors were 4th.

The Club membership has decreased from 190 2 years ago to 148 and now 142. When it is recalled that the Club membership 14 years ago was 249 and 10 years ago 208 it means that immediate and serious thought must be given to this matter. It would appear that athletes at present in state and Club is at the crossroads, because there is evidence that membership has decreased in the Metropolitan area yet the population over the past 15 years has increased considerably.

It is also quite apparent that the keeness in Club competitions has decreased substantially in the past 5 years, as it is practically impossible to gather track athletes together for senior competition. The comradeship that is developed through club competition is something that should not be lightly cast aside as it is felt that this is the real basis of our sport and it is this absence of club competitive spirit that is probably gnawing at our membership.

Good coaching and plenty of training are basic requirements for our sport but with many of our athlotes the running of miles in training has become an obsession and in many instances the result has been a slowing down of speed as there is not sufficient sharp competition. Competition also gives the athlete that necessary judgment of pace which is frequently missing, it also gives determination to hang on which cannot be achieved completely in training alone.

It must be remembered that all athletes cannot be a Dave Power or a Albert Thomas, where they have the stamina to stand ruthless training. A return to plenty of Senior Club Competitions next track season is earnestly desired. as without it the Club will surely lose further members and eventually become financially embarrassed.

Last year attention was drawn to the fact that members Club costumes could be improved and it is with a lot of pleasure that a big improvement has been in this regard during the past 12 months and congratulations are extended to Ron Gribble (Distance) and Kevin Taylor (Track) for being adjudged the best dressed athletes after very keen competition.

To Fred Larcombe we once again extended our sincere congratulations for organising the Annual Schoolboy Championships at Kogarah Jubilee Oval Saturday 15th September. Entries as usual were up to standard and while thanking Fred for another grand job we also remember his

Through the efforts of the members and friends who attended the functions we were able to present the Mens and Ladies Club with £25 each.


