NATIONAL FITNESS HALL, BANEGATE ON FRIDAY, 29TH JUNE, 1984 AT 7.45 p.m.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The 43rd Annual Report and Balance Sheet is presented to you tonight and the report will show that our performances were no better than the previous year, mainly due to the fact that again our senior athletes' performances were not good at Interclub level, Summer and Winter, nor in State Championships.

During the year the only bright spots came from the magnificent performances of our younger athletes and the continued success of the support given to the Winter season at Scarborough Park.

Last Interclub Season (Summer) we combined with Bankstown Sports Club and the newly formed Police Club, but unfortunately their support was not as good as expected.

John, by the above performances was again adjudged the Best Senior Athlete and this entitled him to the ALLEYN BAINSFORD TROPHY for the fifth year in succession. John has been attached to the Australian Institute of Sport at Canberra for the past twelve months at 25% a year we do not see this talented athlete ever often at Club and Intertested trials.

Alan Staples and Steve Wilson, Distances and Track Secretaries, have prepared reports where all results and details are shown, while our Senior athlete, during the Winter did not perform well, Col Williams ran his best race time for 1963 in the Australian Title race over 2 hours 28 minutes 09 seconds, Col also gained eighth place in the 5' Distance Runner of the Year.

In the State Marathons, St. George gained third place in the team event, while Col Williams finished fifth in 2 hours 28 minutes 28 seconds. Brilliant 15 year old, Philip Warren's performances during the Winter were as follows:

The Under 16 athletes ran particularly well to win both Cross events in the State 4 Km Cross Country Championships and the State 4 x 2 Km Road Relays. Other athletes who performed during the Winter included Evelyn Argall, who gained 2nd place in the State 1/20 & 1/10 Cross Country and 7th place in the Australian Title over the same distance.

Mark Train gained 3rd place in the H.S.W. All Schools/Under 17 & 18 Cross Country.

Matthew Fode finished 4th in the Open 10 Km Nordic Cross Country and recording the good time of 32 min 20 sec.

Warragul Park was again very popular with large numbers of athletes competing, which resulted in very fine Points Score Competitions.

The brilliant performances of our young athletes was easily the outstanding feature of the Track season and their efforts were rewarded when they won the John Treloar Shield, awarded to the Club gaining the most points in the Under 16 years H.S.W. Track & Field Series Championships.

Alan Blum, Mark Irwin, Tim Argall, Paul Jones, Robert Fong, Harry Pavlitis, Gary Chiswick, Duncan Reutens and Chris Hetheritt. With such talent as mentioned above we can look forward to the future with optimism.

Without doubt Robert Henderson was the backbone of our Senior athletes, and his ultimate performances during the season were excellent, winning places in the final of both the State 100 m and 200 m. He was also selected to run in International Meetings and the Australian Track and Field Games Championships. It was most gratifying to see the fine improvement of Andrew Duthie in sprint events and he should do very well next season.

One of the best results for our Senior numbers was gaining 3rd place in the Senior State relay over 4 x 100 m. the team Andrew Duthie, Craig Sams, Robert Henderson and Paul McCaffery.

Club members were highly delighted to learn that Andrew Scott and Mark Jones passed their final examinations for Medicine, meaning of course, we have two doctors in our ranks. Again our congratulations.

Mark Jones, short of committee, gained 3rd place in the State 3,000 m Steeplechase, quite a good performance.

Another good performance was that of Matthew Todd, gaining 4th place in the State Mile in 4 minutes 15.57 seconds.

Club membership has increased from 265 to 307 but it is noticed that we have 344 competing athletes vs against 177 the previous year. Senior members numbers are slowly going down and for the past three years the numbers have been 70-70 and one is all we can to be honest that this number will increase next year.

From the excellent Financial Statement and Balance Sheet prepared by our Treasurer, it can be seen that the Club is in a sound financial position. This is most gratifying, but with ever increasing costs it is necessary that members support throughout the year, the Club's activities, athletically and socially.

The level of Club funds stand at \$6,000.41, approximately the same as previous years and this can be considered most satisfactory. Donors to Club funds are thanked for their contributions and we also keep in mind those officials and members who promote and financially support Club functions throughout the year. Particular thanks to Rotarians Walkers for their donation of \$400.

Country visits by our track athletes have again proved most successful under the management of Arthur Park and Alan Devin.

The Ladies Social Committee again worked magnificently during the past 12 months, the Club benefiting by nearly \$2,000. These ladies are a very happy group, which is particularly noticed at Scarborough Park during the Winter season. The Committee is again headed by Terri Page, President, Jean Heitke, Secretary and Cheryl Dray, Treasurer.

In conclusion, I feel the Club is functioning extremely well from Executive levels, various committees, officials and members. We are a happy Club and I close my report a proud President and I wish you all well for the 1984-85 season.

In the early 1930s the Coppock Cross Country course took in most of the airfield where the seaplane depot, Jack's canvas enclosed wagon was also well known for taking as many as 14 young athletes to Cross Country courses as far away as Campbelltown. I close this Tribute with my deepest sympathy to his wife Bell and family.

HARRY COATES: Harry was a member of our Club for approximately ten years and during this time he acted as timekeeper, judge and gear official.

Harry, one of the older members of the Club, used to like running with the older brigade (50 years and over), particularly Cross Country and on the track. He is already missed by the older boys, who recall the many enjoyable occasions they had together. I close this Tribute with my deepest sympathy to Mrs. Coates and family.

The 1983 winter session saw very large numbers of athletes compete each Saturday at Scarborough Park. Competition was intense and the final individual point scores were very close. Congratulations and thanks to our handicappers Stan Doneelly, Arthur Peek, Gethy Delamare, Phil Tonge and John Cook for an excellent job. Thanks also to our President, Mr. Bainbridge, for keeping the afternoon's activities running as close to schedule as possible each week, and to Ron Griddle and the Ladies Social Committee for the refreshments and weekly "Gussiness Competition".

It was a lean season for senior runners. Many of our better athletes were injured or absent for much of the season. Our best senior men's team result was third in the marathon. Col Whiteman had a successful season and finished 8th in the Distance Runner Of the Year Award. But St. George's strength was in the younger divisions. The Boys Under 16 team won the State 4 Km title. The Under 16 team came second in the State 6 Km title, while in the Road Relays, the Under 16 team came 1st, the Under 18 3rd and the Women's Under 20 2nd. These were the outstanding team efforts but we are most fortunate in having many promising athletes to give support and depth to our top teams.

TRACK & FIELD REPORT

1983 - 84 SEASON

Well, here we all are at the end of another busy track season which saw some fine performances throughout the Club. One of the best notable was John Andrews' defeat of Robert de Groot in Canberra over 10,000 m. John, who has spent most of the year training at the Australian Institute of Sport in Canberra, kept the Club colours flying by winning our Club's colours whenever he competed.

There was also Robert Henderson, who joined the Senior ranks this year, and who represented once again, along with John Andrews and Martin Lubman, the Club at the Australian Track & Field Championships in Melbourne.

The N.S.W. Relays Championships and 10,000 metres saw the Club entered in the Relays with 16 teams. The Men's Open 4 x 100 m completed well to win a bronze medal. In the Under 16 age group we won gold medals in the 4 x 100 m & 4 x 200 m & 4 x 400 m and a silver in the 4 x 400 m and a bronze in 4 x 1500 m. A great effort, as all could agree, and indication of our strength as an apposed four years in come. Our Williams ran a respectable sixth in the 10,000 metres' Championship, only two minutes behind the winner.

In the Open Grade Interclub Competition we combined once again with Bankstown Sports and, for the first time, with N.S.W. Police Club. The "A" grade retained the Premiership for the second year running, and the "B" grade came in second behind Liberty Nation/Burwood. Our "A" and "B" grades managed to finish within the "C" grade race a respectable fourth. The results could have been greatly improved if our club had not been split between the field, which kept a large number of the younger athletes away from the higher grades. The splitting of the Club has affected the Club's team spirit and failed to detract from overall performance but it is our athletes - whether from the Bankstown-Hanbury,

After Christmas the Administration held several competitions in which we competed in our own. Our athletes were again spread between the grounds, and for the first time results were mixed with the "D" and "E" grades, who were still competing in the Interclub competition. However, with the Club at full strength for the first three months, "A" and "B" grades managed to finish mid-table, while "C" grade finished second. A fine effort considering "E" and "D" grades failed to score any points in the first three events.

This year saw the return of the Southern Zone Competition. However, most of our athletes preferred to continue competing at Bankstown Oval on Tuesday nights, and to avoid the older athletes at Open Grade Interclubs.

Our Club once again attended the country meetings. Our best outstanding result was achieved in the Australian Day relays in Canberra, where the Club won the boys' relay club and the senior men's overall. Club athletes also attended Regis, Orange, South Coast, Broken, Cooma and the Bells Track and Field Championships, where the Club was very successful, winning nine medals and feature events.

Congratulations to all the athletes from the Club who were involved in our Friendship victory and our many successful trips to the major meets. The success of our athletes this season has helped our Club to a very prosperous and enjoyable summer track season.

It can be seen from the following results that the St. George Club has done excellently well at the many different competitions and carnivals our athletes attended.

A special note of thanks to Alan Parks and Arthur Best for all their assistance and for helping to make my job as Track Secretary as easy as it could be.
