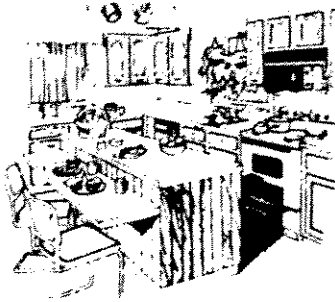

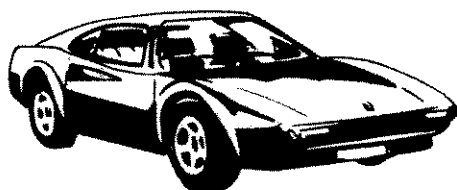

65th ANNUAL REPORT AND BALANCE SHEET

*Presented to Members at the Annual General Meeting held at Scarborough Park
National Fitness Hall, Ramsgate on Friday, 30th May, 1986 at 7.45 p.m.*

Ladies and Gentlemen,

The 65th Annual Report and Balance Sheet is presented to you tonight and the report will show that our performances were not as good as the previous year and this particularly applied to the performances of senior athletes during the Summer season.

During the year, again our younger athletes performed very well, and our distance runners showed up better than the previous year.

Once again Scarborough Park was a hive of activity during the Winter. As usual Scarborough is a real centre for athletes with the best facilities in State.

Results Interclub E.A. Marks Ground

A Grade — 6th place — 9 Clubs

C Grade — 5th place — 8 Clubs

Results Hensley Ground

D Grade — 4th place — 6 Clubs

E Grade — 3rd place — 4 Clubs

It is interesting to note that overall we did better than our neighbour club Sutherland. It should also be kept in mind that of the larger clubs, St. George was one of only 2 clubs that competed at Hensley.

WINTER SEASON

St. George during 1985 did quite a good deal better than 1984. We certainly had the best distance runners but unfortunately on 2 occasions we failed to fill teams which cost us the Premiership. Filling of teams is a matter that should be watched by officials. Our record in the Winter Interclub which commenced in 1977 is as follows:-

Lawrie Whitty, by his magnificent running during the year, was our best senior athlete and herewith are some of his most important wins and placings:

3rd — Australian 15K Road Championship, 44m47.3s.

Lawrie's best event is the Marathon, he holds the Club record of 2hr15m23s and with an improvement of just 5 minutes he would be amongst the best athletes in the world.

Lawrie, by the above performances, was adjudged the best senior athlete and this entitled him to the Alleyn Gainsford Trophy for the first time.

Congratulations to Norm Berger, 2nd in the State Marathon and also to Stephen Nobbs, 3rd in the State 16K CCC and 3rd in the Distance Runner of the Year. Other senior runners who performed well were: Matthew Todd, Ray Stephenson, Tom Gibbons, Bruce Hansard, Gary and Stephen McLean and Bruce Graham.

Mark Vassallo of course was our most outstanding young athlete. His best performances were: 1st Australian 6K CCC U18 20m01s; 2nd State CCC U18 20m34s and many fine performances on the track.

We have quite a number of outstanding young athletes appearing and in a few years they should make their presence felt in the older age groups. They are Mark Vassallo, Duncan Davison, Nigel Nixon, Brendon Shaw, Richard and Peter Deutsch, Johnathan Cook, Hung Le, Louis Young, Tim Clarsen, Locke brothers, Randolph and Edward Baral-Steinberg, Matthew Tonge. While we have plenty of young athletes with outstanding talent the Club nevertheless needs field games, hurdlers and jumpers.

Congratulations to Mark Vassallo, Richard Deutsch and Tim Clarsen for gaining silver medals at the Australian T and F Championships. The occasion cannot go by without congratulating our brilliant Under 18 4 x 1500 team who established a State record of 16m36.39s at the NSW relays.

Alan Staples and Arthur Peek, Distance and Track Secretaries for Winter and Summer, have prepared excellent reports where all results and details are shown. It must be said that St. George had a disastrous season Interclub which was common to most clubs. Interclub last season was a shemozzle from start to finish. I have never seen a worst organised Interclub since Interclub was commenced in 1924. Athletes of most clubs were disinterested in such a poorly organised Interclub and St. George were to further by competing at two grounds.

Club membership at 162 is not satisfactory and this particularly applies to seniors where numbers have dropped from 99 in 1981 to 60 this year. Under 20, 18 and 16 years numbers have fallen and with a drive for new members, we hope that membership will increase. I believe that most clubs have lost athletes, and the Association has lost approximately 2000 registrations.

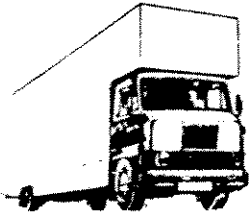
From the excellent financial statement and balance sheet prepared by our Treasurer it can be seen that the Club is in a sound financial position. The level of club funds stand at \$6407.09 which is satisfactory.

Athletes have benefited to the extent of \$2050.00 for representation mainly overseas and interstate, therefore, we look forward to members and friends supporting our Club functions whenever possible.

Donors to Club funds are thanked for their contributions but we must remember those officials and members who promote and financially support Club functions throughout the year.

Once again the Winter season at Scarborough Park has been most successful, very popular with athletes, their families and friends. Our excellent conditions at Scarborough I feel could be the envy of other clubs and athletes should keep in mind the fast conditions, where keeping up your speed from marathon downwards is so necessary these days. Officials do a magnificent job during the Winter and particularly on championship days.

ALLEYN GAINSFORD, O.A.M.

Away back in March 1921, as a mere slip of a lad, Alleyn Gainsford helped to form our St. George Athletic Club and then won the first race organised by the new Club. Now, after the passing of 65 very active years, Alleyn — well past four score years — is as bright and cheery as ever, AND is still working untiringly for the sport in addition to other community projects, including scouting.

Here are some highlights of a very busy career:-

Mr Gainsford is a Life Member, Vice President (for over 40 years) and at times was Acting President of the State Athletic Association. For fifty years he has been the most energetic President of any sporting club in NSW. Not only did he compete in distance events for nearly forty years, with several Clubs, State and Australian records, but was also a competent walker for the Club. For over a decade he was rarely beaten in State 10 and 15 miles Championships and ran in Australasian Championships in N.Z. (1925).

Over the years Alleyn served on several civic-sponsored patriotic and celebration committees (often as Chairman or M.C.) and as a member of Scarborough Park National Fitness Committee and St. George Sports Medicine Executive. He is a Foundation/Life Member of the travel group SKAL. As a member of Australian Olympic and Commonwealth Games Councils for many years he helped with fund raising and organising supporting athletic contests, particularly as a member of the Athletic Organising committees of 1938 Empire and 1956 Olympic Games.

Alleyn was Manager of the 1969 Australian Athletic Team competing in California in the USA-Russia-Commonwealth meet.

The highest Layside Scouting honour was granted to our President for his sterling work as Chairman of St George Scouts, and Area Chairman and also as an Executive member of the NSW Scouting Association for over twenty years.

The conferring of the Order of Australia Medal was a fitting acknowledgment of Alleyn's very capable and enthusiastic community service, which is further indicated by the personal respect of members of parliament, councils and the many kindred organisations and people in this enterprising St. George District.

Thank you Alleyn for the high standard you always maintained in dedicating so much of your time and energy for all of us in the St. George area and particularly as this Club's eminent President for these fifty years.

Thank you too, Stella for your forbearance, patience, tolerance and inspiration. We feel sure you can both look back over these years and get the same extreme satisfaction as you gave us from so many tasks so well performed. We look forward to being numbered among your friends for many years.

St George had a reasonably successful season with team performances improving on the 1984 results.

In the Winter Teams Premiership, St George gained equal 3rd place (28 points), our best result since 1981. Our B teams gained 4th place.

In the NSW Distance Runner of the Year (1985) pointscore, Lawrie Whitty (41 points) came 2nd; Stephen Nobbs (34 points) was 3rd and Bruce Graham (24 points) was 9th.

Scarborough Park on Saturday afternoons was once again very successful and enjoyable. Numbers of athletes competing remained fairly stable all season but were not the largest fields we have had in recent years.

The introduction of trophy cycles instead of weekly trophies helped contain the rising costs of hall rental and trophies.

Congratulations to all athletes who were successful during the season and thank you to all club athletes who supported St George by competing in events where team results were important (State Championships particularly). To win team championships it is vital that as many athletes as possible enter the championship, regardless of the athlete's ability. The club urges athletes to fully support all team championship events in 1986.

I am most grateful to the officials for all their help during the past year. The club still needs many more helpers and officials for the major championship days which St George hosts. Anyone able to help should see any of the club executive members.

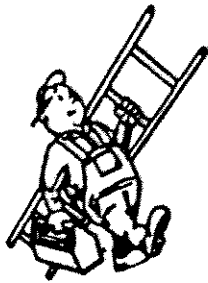

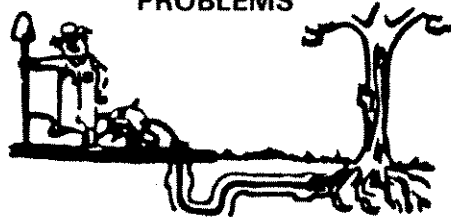

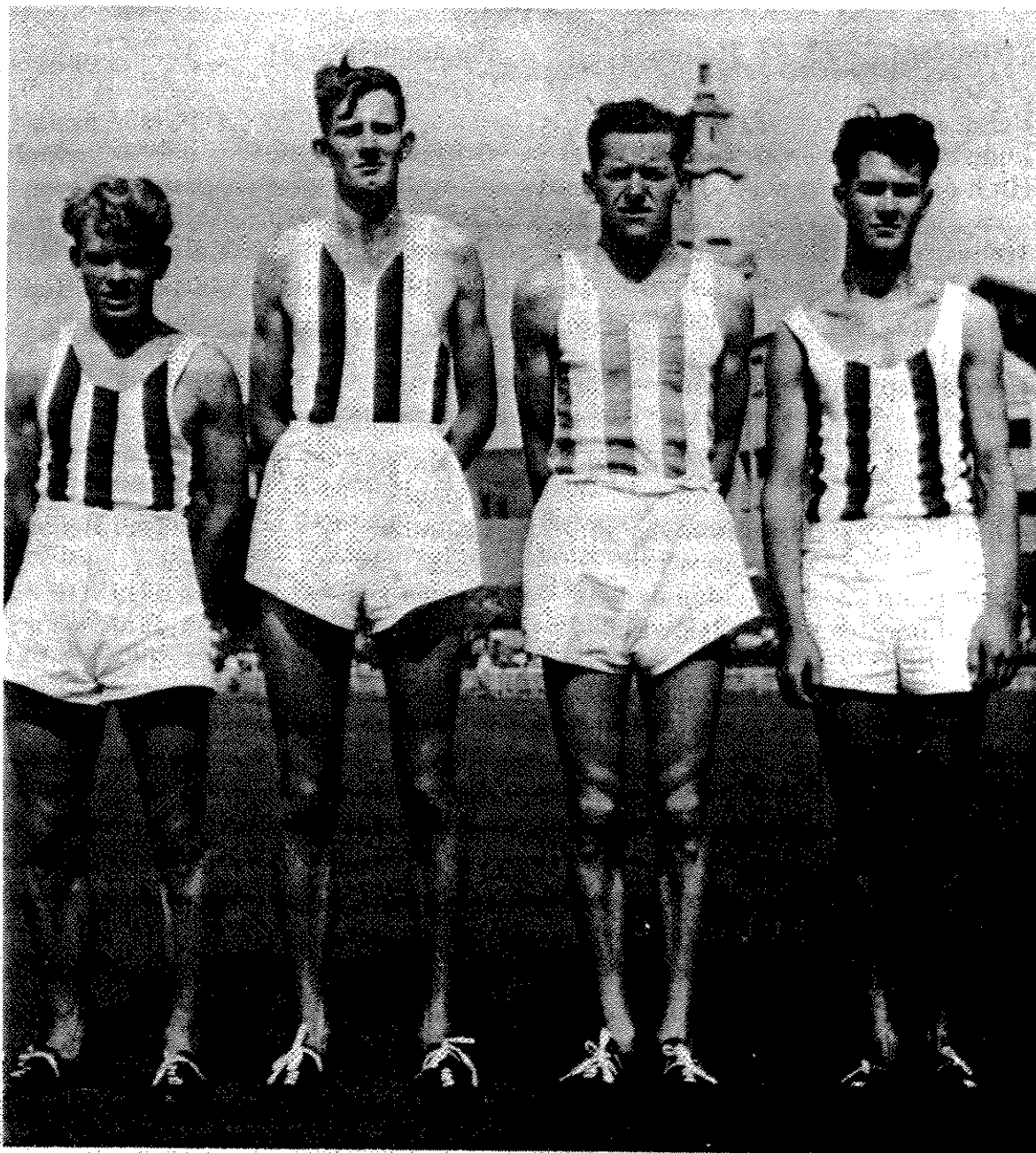

1985-86 TRACK SEASON REPORT

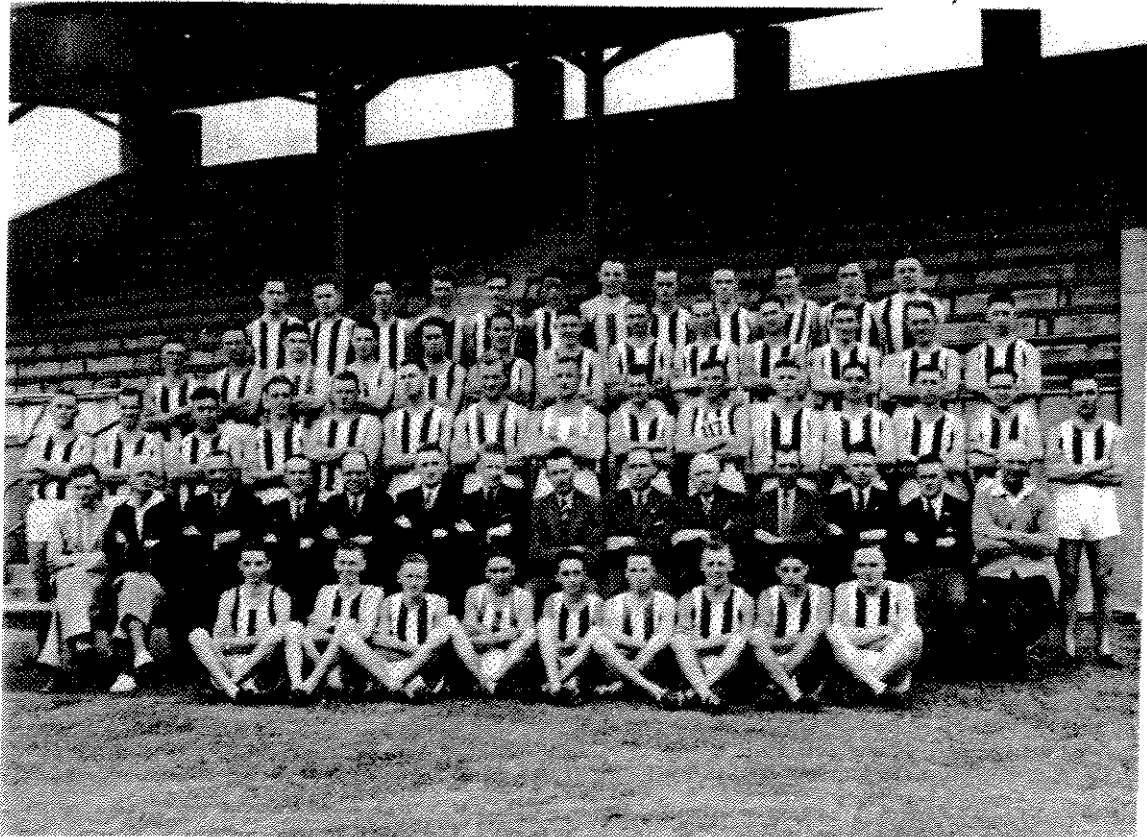
The Summer season no sooner started and it was all over for the 1985-86 Track season. Interclub competition was held for several rounds only, one of the shortest competitions ever seen for a Summer season, on both Sydney Athletic Field and Hensley Athletic Field. The first round of competition commenced on 3rd November, 1985 — a very late start to the season. Two types of competition were available to our athletes: club versus club competition and seeded events were held on Interclub days.

Due to an apparent lack of interest by our athletes, the results in A, C, D and E Grades were not good this year. "A" grade managed one win in seven matches, "C" grade had two wins in seven matches, "D" grade had two wins in seven matches and "E" grade has three wins from seven matches. It could be seen by the weekly result sheets that many clubs had few or no competitors in most events. St. George was no exception. With a little better attendance all grades would have finished with much better results.

A major factor against our Club is the fact that the Club was split between two grounds and this seems to be the cause of the lack of club spirit nowadays during the Summer season, which was not the case only a few seasons ago.

However, we did have a few highlights this summer. The Under 18 years 4 x 1500 metres relay team set a new N.S.W. State Record for the event at S.A.F. on 7.12.85. A brilliant team effort by Nigel Nixon, Mark Vassallo, Marco Zamarrelli and Randolph Baral-Steinberg paved the way for an excellent time of 16min36.39secs. Our medal tally was one gold, two silver and one bronze.

The Dunn Shield competition was held at S.A.F. on 15.2.86 and 1.3.86, after the seven rounds of Interclub. Due to our poor attendances at Interclub we

were placed in Division 3 this year after winning Division 2 last year. After encountering little or no opposition throughout the competition, the small team competing for the St. George Club won by a very big margin.

Our best junior athletes competed successfully this year at the Australian Schools and Australian Track and Field Championships held in Perth, Hobart and Adelaide. Mark Vassallo, Richard Deutsch and Tim Clarsen all won silver medals for their events with Duncan Davison, Peter Deutsch and Randolph Baral-Steinberg doing well in their events.

Southern Zone competition was held on Friday nights at Sylvania Waters Athletic Field. The competition commenced in September and finished in February with the running of the Angus and Cooté Shield. This is a competition between the Zone Clubs in the Sydney Metropolitan Area. Southern Zone were clear winners this year and many of our athletes participated in the events contested. Sutherland Men and Women's Clubs and St. George Men and Women's Clubs made up the bulk of competitors.

Attendance at Harold Fraser Oval was very poor this year. It is a good grass track and was in excellent condition throughout the summer but only a few Club athletes used the ground for training.

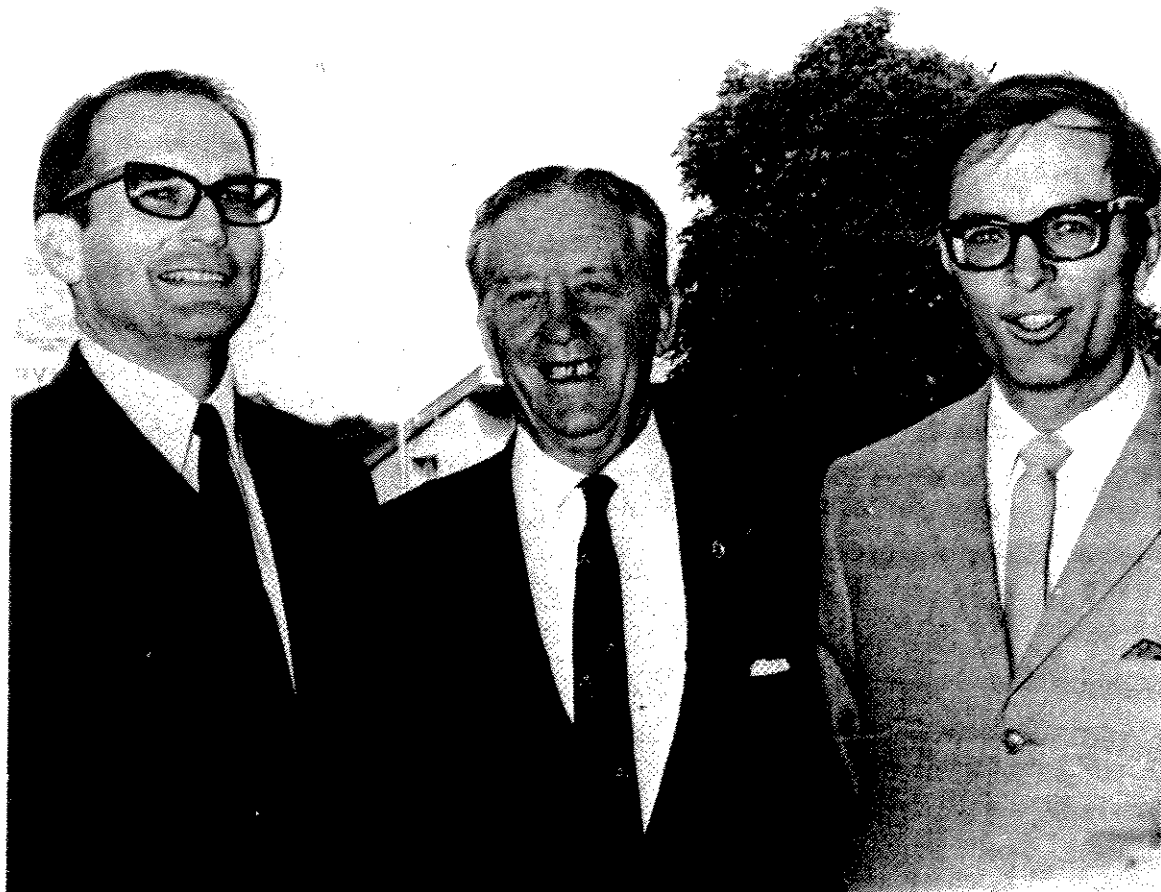

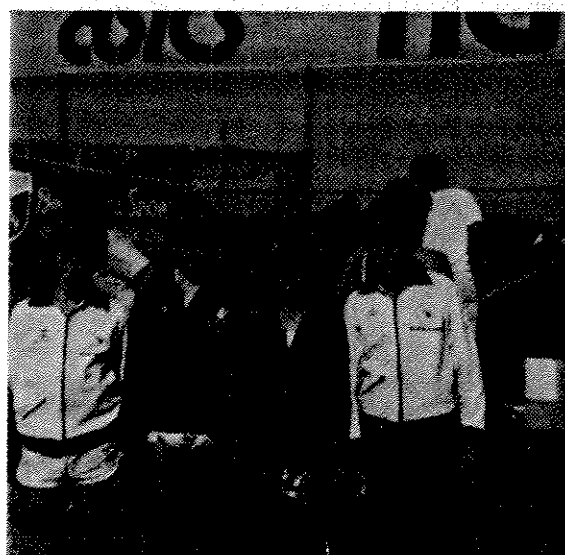

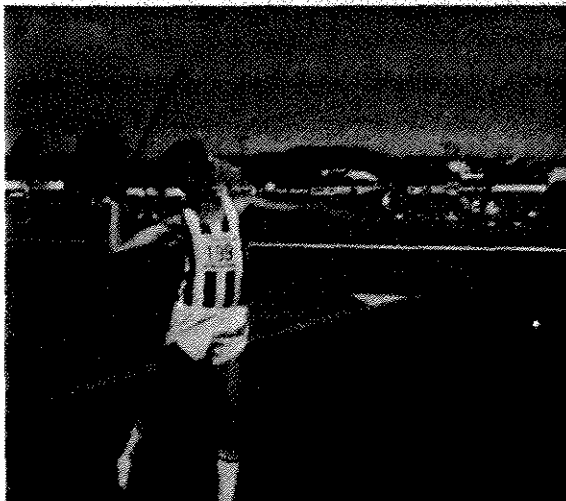
