#### 67th ANNUAL REPORT & BALANCE SHEET

Presented to Members at the Annual General Meeting held at Scarborough Park National Fitness Hall, Ramsgate on Friday, 24th June, 1988 at 7.45pm

#### Ladies and Gentleman,

The 67th Annual Report and Balance Sheet is presented to to you tonight and the report will show that our performances during the Track Season were disastrous. Interclub results were no better than last year when they were the worst since 1924, the year Interclub commenced. Results will be found in Arthur Peek's report. Fortunately, our distance runners had a very good season. Finances of the Club are very good and the Ladies Social Committee had an excellent year.

Once again Scarborough Park was a hive of activity during the Winter. As usual Scarborough is a real centre for athletes with the best facilities in the State.

#### Winter Season

St George gained 2nd place in the State Premiership, same place as 1986. We certainly had the best distance runners but again failed to fill teams in all State Championships. Our record in Winter Interclub, which commenced in 1977, is as follows:-

The highlight of the Winter season was the winning of the NSW Road Relay at Nowra. St George fielded its best team, viz, John Andrews 29m 54s, Stephen Nobbs 30m 42s, Louis Young 31m 17s and Lawrie Whitty 29m 10s. The team broke the best on record time by approximately 1min 30secs and in so doing beat the crack Camberwell Victorian team by nearly a minute and thirty seconds.

Results of State and Club Championships will be found in Allan Staples' report.

John Andrews, by his magnificent running during the year, at International and Australian level, was our best Senior athlete. Probably his best effort was establishing a new Club record in 13 mins 42.37 secs for the 5000m. His other outstanding performances can be found in Arthur Peek's and Allan Staples' reports. John, by his performances, was adjudged the best Senior Athlete and this entitled him to the Alleyn Gainsford trophy.

With distance runners of the calibre of:- Andrews, Whitty, Nobbs, Todd, Young, McLean, Hansard and McRae we should again do well in Senior State Championships. Senior distance athletes are expected to compete at State Championships if we are to maintain our great record since the Club was formed in 1921. Our younger athletes have not performed well during the past 12 months and this is an area where we must build up as soon as possible. We still have young athletes of promise including the Locke brothers, Ferguson, Berger, Argall, Jenkins, Zammarrelli and Cook.

Last year, I said the women of our Club were gathering strength and performance all the time, and this has been maintained particularly during the Winter season. Presently, our women distance runners would be the best in the State.

Most sincere congratulations to Pat Marshall who won the State Marathon for women in 2hrs 52mins 03secs. Pat is the first woman in our Club to win a State Marathon. Congratulations also to Barbara Mrakovcic for winning the State Mile in 4min 57.48secs and 2nd place in the Australian Mile in 4min 46.70secs (new Club record). Seniors who have performed particularly well include Pat Marshall, Barbara Mrakovcic, Mandy Dovey and Christine Batman who together gained 4 places in the first six for the NSW Distance Runner of the Year, easily the best of all clubs. Brilliant young athletes Michelle Dillon and Lisa Zammarrelli gained firsts in State events. Other outstanding young girls include Karen Holgate, Linda Horrocks, Beth Walsh, Christine and Suzanne Stratford and Natasha Dillon. Other young girls are showing promise and we hope that more women athletes attend Interclub next track season.

Club membership at 137 is far from satisfactory when we realise we had 202 members in 1984. Members should try and bring new members into the Club especially for the track season. I still feel we should have a Membership committee and here is an opportunity for someone to come forward.

From the excellent financial statement and balance sheet prepared by our Treasurer it can be seen that the Club is in a very sound financial position. The level of club funds stands at \$10,366.09 which again is most satisfactory. Athletes have benefited to the extent of \$896.00 which is a lower amount than usual, mainly because of fewer State Representatives. Donors to Club funds are thanked for their contributions but we must remember those officials and members who promote and financially support club functions throughout the year. Thanks once again to the Ladies' Social Committee who, during the past 12 months, raised approximately \$2000.

A special thank you to Bill Seary who was responsible for the magnificent financial help from the Southside Masters Fun Run. We must also keep in mind the great financial help we receive from Buttercup Bakeries for the Annual Schools Track and Field Championships at Harold Fraser Oval.

I close my report a proud President about to commence my 53rd year unopposed.

I wish you all well for the coming 12 months, 1988-89.

# OBITUARY

Since our last Annual Meeting one of our most prominent members, Harold Bennett, of the early years of our Club, has passed away and we pay tribute to him.

A TRIBUTE TO THE LATE HAROLD BENNETT

The passing of Harold Bennett on the 12th July 1987 brought to a close a career in athletics which commenced in 1924 and finished in 1945. Harold joined our Club on 7th April 1924 and ran the distance season of 1924 before turning his talents to the Track events in the years 1924 to 1929.

His best performance was 3rd place in the State 440 yards at Manly Oval on 27th February 1929. In so doing he was the first St George athlete to record a place in the sprint events, viz, 100, 220 and 440 yards. Harold, at Interclub and Club level, enjoyed success and at different times he was Club Champion for the 220 yds, 440 yds and 440 yards Hurdles where he established a club record of 61.4 seconds. At the Mascot Dog track on the 18th February 1929 Harold won the Open AAA 440 yards.

Harold occupied many official positions as follows: -

He	also acted as Handicapper,	Starter and Vice Captain.

Harold was the manager of a St George Athletics Club team which created history when they flew to Maitland on 16th February 1935 and piloted by Sir Charles Kingsford-Smith in the' famous "Southern Cross". On the way to Maitland the "Southern Cross" circled Sydney Harbour and dropped a wreath in memory of the late Charles Ulm.

Although Harold lived at Lindfield for many years he always attended the magnificent reunions and cocktail parties of old athletes and their friends. Harold was a very popular member and with his passing I lost one of my dearest friends. He was with Wormald Bros Pty Ltd for most of his working life and ascended to the position of Associate Director.

Vale my friend.

This tribute closes with deepest sympathy to his wife, Irene, and to Helen, Susan, Rosemary and Stephen.

### 1987-88 TRACK SEASON REPORT by Arthur Peek

The 1987-88 summer track season saw a combined effort between St. George, Bankstown Sports and Canterbury Bankstown athletics clubs in the Mens A and C Grades at Interclub. The combination was necessary as not one of the three clubs was strong enough to compete on its own. However, the combined effort made the team more competitive in both grades. St George and Bankstown combined in C Grade for the Womens competition.

Unfortunately the A Grade team in the Mens competition did not perform up to expectations, managing two wins in the season over a very weak Nepean club. It appears that both clubs will be relegated from A grade next season. Only twelve athletes from St George, nine from Bankstown and four from Canterbury Bankstown competed during the season. This was only half the number of athletes to make the team competitive. On the the first day of competition, 10th October 87, only three athletes competed in A Grade and this was the same story on 31st October 87.

The combined C Grade team did well to finish second in the competition. Twenty-five athletes from St George, seventeen from Bankstown and two from Canterbury Bankstown competed during the season. Most of the events in the match each day had at least one or two competitors. Unfortunately, the numbers were down on two days of competition and both matches were lost. They were the only losses for the season, and the combined team was strong enough to win the C Grade competition.

Only six competitors competed in the Womens C Grade competition, five athletes from St George and one from Bankstown Sports. It was one of the weakest competitions ever held by the NSW AAA and next year only A and B Grades will be held for the women. The combined team finished fourth in the competition.
