



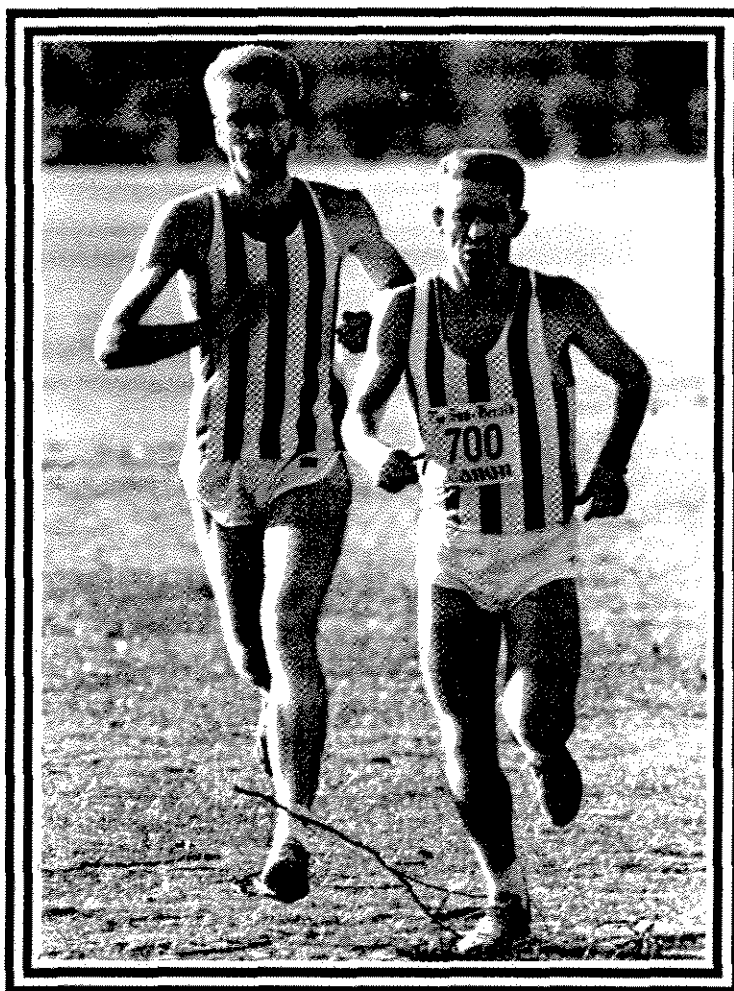

PRESENTED TO MEMBERS AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT SCARBOROUGH PARK NATIONAL FITNESS HALL, RAMSGATE ON FRIDAY 30TH JUNE 1989 AT 7.45 PM

Ladies and Gentlemen

The 68th Annual Report and Balance Sheet is presented to you tonight and the report will show that we have had a most successful Winter Season with many outstanding performances. The Track Season results will show quite an improvement compared with performances for the past four years. Once again Scarborough Park was a hive of activity during the Winter Season. As usual Scarborough is a real centre for athletes with the best facilities in the State. It is apparent that parents of our younger athletes enjoy the Park.

Winter Season - Men

St George gained 3rd place in the State Premiership. We certainly had the best distance runners but again failed to fill teams in all State Championships. Our record in Winter Interclub, which commenced in 1977, is as follows:

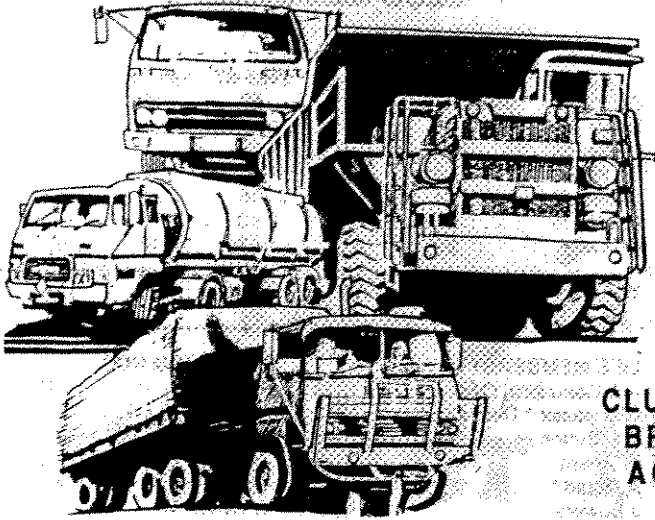

John Andrews by his magnificent running during the year, at International and Australian level, was our best senior athlete. His best Performances would be over 5000m, 13m36.54s, at Melbourne, and the Chicago Marathon, 2hr14m44s, on 13th October 1988. His other outstanding performances can be found in Arthur Peek's and Chris Stratford's reports. John, by his performances, was adjudged the best Senior Athlete and this entitled him to the Alwyn Gainsford Trophy. With distance runners of the calibre of Andrews, Whitty, Young, Hansard, McRae, McLean, Nobbs and Vassallo, we should again do well in Senior State Championships. Senior distance runners are expected to compete at State Championships if we are to maintain our great record since the Club was formed in 1921.

Winter Season - Women

Our women athletes have had an outstanding season and I think it necessary that they come under a special heading. Their State efforts in team events is quite magnificent as follows:

5 seconds

In the younger group we have quite a number of promising girls and, in a few years, they will make their presence felt at junior level and later within the senior ranks.

The women's outstanding achievement was the winning of the State Premiership. Congratulations to Michelle Dillon for winning the State 3km CC U16 in 11m36s. This young lady is improving all the time and in a few years she could win senior State Championships. Again congratulations to Barbara Mrakovcic, Lisa Zammarrelli, Linda Horrocks, Lisa Hopkins, Beth Walsh, Stratford girls, Mandy Dovey, Louise Bennett, Annette Gaborov and that great trier, Narelle Hocking.

Most of these girls have been in amongst the State Medals. Many other younger girls are showing promise and it is hoped that more women athletes will attend Interclub next Track season.

Club Membership

At 141 can be improved. It is 4 above last year's numbers. We keep in mind that in recent years our numbers have gone down approximately 17 each year which, in effect, means that this year we have increased membership by approximately 21. A membership Committee I still feel could help to increase our numbers.

Olds Park

Just a few years ago Arthur Peek, Alan Staples, Bob Molloy and myself met officials of the St George Little Amateur Athletic Club, together with officials of the St George Women's AA Club to discuss the possibility of using Olds Park as our Headquarters for the Summer Season. Other meetings followed and last Track Season we had our first Summer Season at Olds Park, which is the property of Hurstville Municipality. By going to Olds Park we met with immediate success, with an attendance of 40 to 50 members each Wednesday night. I feel the move to Olds Park mainly responsible for our increased membership. I take this opportunity of congratulating Arthur Peek for his organising and the tremendous work that he has done at the ground, and all members should respond in some way or attend the ground as some reward for Arthur's efforts.

From the excellent Financial Statement and Balance Sheet prepared by our Treasurer, it can be seen that the Club is in a very sound financial position. The level of Club funds stands at \$12,778.72 which is a record and is most satisfactory. Athletes have benefitted to the extent of \$1300 for travelling expenses, mostly for Interstate and overseas.

Donors to Club funds are thanked for their contributions but we must remember those officials and members who promote and financially support Club functions throughout the year.

Thanks once again to the Ladies' Committee which raised approximately \$3,000 during the past twelve months. The Committee is headed by Vice President, Pat Donnelly.

Again a special Thank You to Bill Seary who was responsible for

the magnificent help from the Southside Masters Fun Run. For the next Fun Run Bill needs additional help, especially at executive level, and I trust that this help will be forthcoming.

We must also keep in mind the great financial help we receive from Buttercup Bakeries for the Annual Schools' Track and Field Championships. The next 49th Annual Championships will be held at Olds Park for the first time on Sunday 22nd October 1989.

I close my report a proud President.

I wish you all well for the coming twelve months, 1989/90.

year were very good and he was running better than he has for a couple of seasons. In the Road Relays, Lawrie Whitty excited the small crowd on hand with his determined running in the last leg of the relay by nearly snatching victory with a run of over two minutes better than his Sutherland rival. Lawrie, in fact, started the last leg in fifth place and the crowd buzzed with excitement as he powered his way past rival after rival but narrowly failed to overhaul the winner.

Special thanks go to Barbara Mrakovcic who competed in all Premiership events and she must be well satisfied with her results during the winter season. Last, but not least, the club appreciated the efforts of Rory McRae, Gary McClean, Paul Gallaher, Andrew Mrakovcic and Bruce Hansard for frequently representing the club at Premiership events.

In the younger age groups we have a flourishing Under 12 competition and some races on Saturday at Scarborough attracted large fields. We have a very fine group of female athletes from Under 12 to Under 18 and this was proved by some excellent individual and team performances. We were pleased with the fine running of Andrew Kelly and Jolyon Rice who joined the club this season and the improvement shown by Geoff Argall.

During the 1988 Winter season St George gained minor successes in the Road Walking Championships. Suzanne Stratford was second in the NSW Schools Championships and her sister, Christine, continued her good form from the summer by coming third in the Under 16 Championship. St George has not had a lot of success at Road Walking over the years and these minor successes can only help to build our club.

I would like to thank, very much, all those club members, their parents and friends who helped as officials during the season, and in particular the social committee, whose members devoted many hours to help raise funds for the club and its athletes.

In adverse conditions, John maintained his rating as one of the best distance track runners in Australia. After finishing second in this event last year to Andrew Lloyd in Melbourne, John broke through for a much deserved victory this year.

The Club is at its strongest financial standing ever. In February 1989 the Club took advantage of high interest rates and invested \$6,000 in GIO deposits at 17% pa for 12 months. The growth in Club funds is due to the fund raising efforts of Club members, particularly those associated with the sale of refreshments, raffles, and organising the Southside Masters Fun Run. Financially, there is little benefit from our cross country races or the Schools Track and Field Championships. However, these promotions do contribute to Club funds with refreshment sales, and in the case of the Schools Championships, with the generous sponsorship of Buttercup Bakeries. With the move to Olds Park and the consequential improved attendances, once again track competition is contributing to Club funds.

There were no social functions during the 1989 season, yet the Saturday afternoons at Scarborough Park were in themselves like social gatherings.

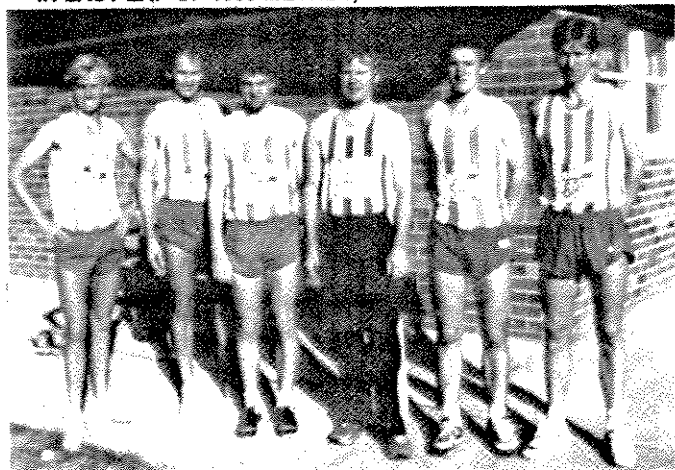

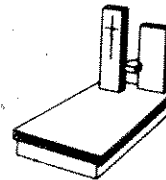
