There are three distinct categories into which club members can be placed. These are -

(A) Open, Associates and Officials;

(B) Athletes 16 years and over but under 20; and

(C) Athletes less than 16 years.

The Club has experienced growth in categories B and C, while the open and officials category remained virtually static. The resurgence in membership is particularly encouraging and is due in part to the efforts of the Club's executive and a policy towards family registrations by Athletics NSW.

During 1992-93, the Club received 41 new members and had 128 renewals, compared to 31 new members and 126 renewals for the previous year. 107 members, including 49 athletes under 16, were members for the full year; 46 registered for the winter season; and 16 registered as summer athletes.



President's Report

Presented to members at the 72nd Annual General Meeting held at Syd Frost Memorial Hall, Hawthorne Street, Ramsgate on Friday 25 June 1993 at 7.45pm

Ladies and Gentlemen,

We can all feel pleased with our club's progress both on and off the field in the past year. Athletes have improved their performances and club administration has progressed in our desire to increase assistance to athletes and to raise the image of our club.

It has been gratifying to witness more involvement by members in club activities and with this increased enthusiasm it is predicted that we will be able to add to and build on our future goals.

Membership of our club has increased for the second successive year to be our highest for 8 years. This is a good sign and considering the increase is in our junior ranks it augurs well for our future. There are many varieties of sport and recreational activities these days, all vying for membership, so we must feel encouraged to see our membership rise. However, this is no reason to be complacent. We must invite others to join us and make for more friendships, better competition and a healthy club.

Our younger athletes, in particular, have shown improvement in their various events. Seven of these youngsters represented NSW in Perth last December. They were Tony Auciello, Danielle Ferraro, Saxon Moseley, Belinda Otto, Clinton Pelham, Daniel Simone and Lisa Zammarrelli, who between them, brought back 2 gold, 5 silver, and 1 bronze for their efforts.

The highlight of the winter season would have been the win by our open mens team in the State 6 x 6km Road Relay Championship. We had our best team with Rex Peters, Gary McClean, Lawrie Whitty, Bruce Hansard, Andrew Kelly and John Andrews together for the only time during the season and they dominated the event.

Besides many individual outstanding performances by our athletes, the most important success for our club during the summer season was to win the Womens Interclub "A" Grade competition. As a combined team with Saucony Sutherland, we easily won the final against Blair Central by 136 points to 51 and remained undefeated premiers. This was the first time our club has won or been associated with an "A" grade Interclub Track & Field Premiership by either men or women. Congratulations to our ladies for a fine effort. Anne Manning, our champion racewalker, was undefeated in the walks during the competition with 9 wins, a great effort. Our ladies "B" Grade team also won their Premiership by defeating Blair Central by 114 points to 98. Cathy Williams, Track Captain, was a tower of strength to our womens' Interclub teams and she, herself, scored a record 102 points during the competition.

Our mens "A" Grade Interclub team fought a great battle with Tiger Wests in the final to go right down to the last event, the 3km steeple before Wests edged ahead to win by 161 points to 157.

Our association with Saucony Sutherland as a team for the Track & Field Interclub competition proved a very friendly and successful partnership. As Teams Manager I thank Stan Sheringham and Saucony Sutherland athletes for their co-operation and friendship at all times.

We were easily the most successful team in the Interclub Track & Field series reaching the finals in 6 of the 7 grades of mens and womens competition and winning the Premiership in 3 of these finals.

Anne Manning was rewarded for her wonderful efforts throughout the year when she was chosen to represent Australia in the IAAF World Walking Cup held in Monterrey, Mexico in April 1993. Anne has been a great competitor for our club since she made a comeback to athletics just 2 years ago. Her improvement has been exceptional with personal bests and new club records with every competition. Anne has her sights set on next years Commonwealth Games and the 1996 Olympics.

Another racewalker who performed well, particularly during the winter was Chris Stratford who won both the 20km and 50km State Titles and was placed 2nd in the 30km title. Anne & Chris were both acclaimed NSW Distance Walkers of the year for 1992 by the State Roadwalking Board. Again in the State Track Championships (1993) Anne & Chris were placed in both the 5km & 10km events - a great year for both these athletes.

A new marathon champion has emerged in our ranks. Rex Peters has graduated to this event in the past 12 months with outstanding results. Rex faced an international field in the Melbourne Marathon and was pleased with 8th (2nd Aussie) in a great time of 2hours 20 mins 11 sec a fine effort first up. He followed this with another run of 2h 20m 32s for 2nd placing in the Lake Kawagucki-Ko Marathon, Japan. Rex won his first State Open title when he ran a personal best of 29m 50s to win the 10km track title. He also won the Sutherland Half Marathon during the winter. It was a great year for Rex with more to come this year.

Tony Auciello (17), one of our many talented young athletes was in great form and set new club records for 800m, 1m 51.89s and 1500m 3m 53.9s during the track and field Interclub competition. These times are outstanding for his age and eclipsed John Hancock's under 20 800m record set in 1965.

As of 14 October 1992 our club became incorporated.

Our efforts to seek a sponsor, have an athletic arena constructed at Scarborough Park and form a closer liaison with St.George Little Athletics Centre continue to be our immediate aim and progress is being made in each area.

Cross Country running at Scarborough Park continues to be popular. The new summer cross country competition has attracted more runners. The winter season is the most sociable side of our club and is enjoyed by all who attend and I thank the ladies for preparing afternoon tea each Saturday.

The efforts of Arthur Peek and Peter Tuziak at Olds Park for club track and field competition and training cannot be overlooked and although no substantial increase in numbers is noted, a proposed change to the midweek competition for this coming season hopefully will encourage more athletes to attend.

Arthur Peek is devoted to his coaching duties at Olds Park and I would like to thank Arthur for the time and effort he devotes to athletes and our club. He was also manager on State Novice Cross Country Championship day when our club hosted these very successful titles at Scarborough Park. Our club received written thanks from the Board of Management of ANSW "for a job well done."

Our Club Executive continues to work for the betterment of our athletes and the club in general and I thank all members for their attendance and input at these meetings. I must thank Hurstville City Council for the splendid job in preparing Olds Park for Track & Field athletes during the summer and also Rockdale Municipal Council for keeping the sporting fields and recreation areas at Scarborough Park in apple pie order for cross country running.

I am in constant touch with Secretary Bob Molloy and Treasurer Dennis Jolliffe as well as Distance Secretary Christine Batman and Track Secretary Arthur Peek and I thank you all for your continued support.

Club finances have fallen slightly during the year mainly due to the present downturn in the economy and low interest rates. However, we are grateful to a number of clubs in the St.George district for financial assistance to help club athletes meet travel and accommodation expenses when competing interstate in National Championships.

In addition I must thank Vice President Pat Donnelly and her band of helpers for their untiring efforts with fund raising during the winter season.

Members were saddened with the passing of long time member Fred Eggleton, Life Member of both our club and Athletics NSW and Claude Smeal our Olympic Marathon representative in Helsinki 1952. Please see obituary report.

I conclude my report feeling optimistic with results in the past year and foresee further progress in the coming year.

OBITUARIES

By Emeritus President Alleyn Gainsford Since our last Annual General Meeting two of our members, Fred Eggleton (Life Member) and Claude Smeal (athlete) have passed away.

Tribute to the late Claude Smeal

When Claude Smeal passed away on 1 January 1993, it brought to close a career in athletics from 1948 to 1955. Claude established himself as our best marathon athlete during the years he was a clubmember. His best performance was in winning the State title on 15 September 1951 at Richmond in a time of 2h 48m 6s. Claude's career was mainly in the army where he attained the rank of Lt. Colonel (RL). During war service in Korea in 1952, he was selected to represent Australia in the marathon at the Helsinki Games. He apparently ran a very good time for the marathon in Korea and the army contacted the AAU of Australia and the AOF to confirm his performance. Claude then flew direct to London to join the Australian Team. He finished 45th in the Olympic marathon in a time of 2h 52m 23s. This tribute closes with deepest sympathy to his wife Catherine, and daughters, Margaret, Marilyn and Lynette.

Tribute to the late Fred Eggleton

The passing of Fred Eggleton on 15 February 1993 closed a career in athletics which spanned 45 years from 1948 to 1993. Fred was a leading Fields Game athlete in NSW and his best performances were, Javelin 55-78m, Shot Put 13.36m, Discus 42.07m, Hammer 45.82m. He was Club Champion in these events on many occasions and represented NSW in Australian track & field championships. Fred was closely associated with Athletics NSW and was Board Member for Technical Affairs, a most time consuming position. Fred was a Life Member of Athletics NSW and was very proud of being a Vice President and a Life Member and of our club and would say "this is the one I wanted". He was a club delegate and acted as an official at important track & field meetings and had the honour of being an official at the 1956 Melbourne Olympic Games. He was overseas on war service in 1943-45 mainly in the Pacific Area and was attached to the 2/2nd Commando Unit, Special Forces. His service was clouded in secrecy and his exploits as a commando were never known. Fred always said "I want my ranking to be remembered as a trooper". After his war service he joined Qantas. Fred will be a great loss to athletics and this tribute closes with deepest sympathy to his wife Noeline and daughters, Lynne and Delma.

1992 - 93 Summer Season Review

The success at Interclub at Sydney Athletic Field and the excellent results of our junior athletes at the various track and field championships were the highlights for our club this year. Unfortunately we did also have some disappointing results, but the good did outweigh the bad.

Firstly, we had seven of our younger members travel to Perth for the Australian All Schools T&F C'ships in December, and the club was able to assist with much of the finance needed for the trip, thanks to club funds and some generous sporting and social clubs in the district. At this point in time I have no detail report so I cannot give performances by the athletes involved and perhaps for the future all athletes receiving club assistance should supply a detailed report on their return.

The results of the NSW Relay Championships were excellent with six of our eight teams winning medals. Congratulations to our "golden oldies", the mens over 45 years 4x1500 metres in winning our only gold medal at the championships and to the three teams that set new club records.

The combined Sutherland-St. George interclub teams were very strong in all grades at SAF and were successful in winning several grades. Congratulations to all athletes involved and especially Keiran Gallagher, one of only three athletes with a 100% attendance and winner of the interclub point score trophy. We had a total of 34 club athletes involved with interclub at SAF and the overall attendance was disappointing. There were only nine rounds of interclub for the summer season (far too few) yet we could only manage a small attendance on each day of competition (round 1=15, 2=11, 3=14, 4=15, 5=12, 6=12, 7=10, 8=9, 9=18). I believe Ron Gribble was consistently chasing athletes by phone in attempts to fill all grades throughout the season. Attendance by our athletes could be a lot better and must be rectified for next season.



Congratulations also to Anne Manning and Chris Stratford for an excellent walking season, and both recording 100% attendance at interclub. See Ron Gribbles detailed report on interclub for all details.

Outer ground interclub at Hensley Athletic Field provided competition for our athletes who could not make the qualifying standards set for SAF. St. George supplied the strongest team on the ground and combined with the athletes from other clubs made enough for competition. Our club team was far superior throughout the season and won the premiership clearly.

Our participation in the South Western Region interclub series was very poor. There were only four rounds of competition, Bankstown, Olds Park Ingleburn, Illawong, and it was very difficult to find an athlete competing in the red and white singlet. Based on this years results, are we really interested in this competition? We did not even have enough officials at our night for the events to run smoothly. See detailed results for the clubs involved and the placing in the various age division.

Club nights at Olds Park Penshurst were held regularly on Wednesday nights this season and the attendance could be better. In fact any fewer and there would have been little or no competition. Again are our club members interested in a club night during the season?

Summer Cross Country saw an increase in numbers this year over our first year. Competition was keen and usually a field of some 30 runners faced the starter. Scarborough Park is a popular venue for club competition throughout the year and our summer cross country is no exception.

Our club athletes produced some good results at the various track & field championships throughout the season. Many medals were won and many encouraging performances were made - too many to list here but see the detailed reports for results where known.

St. George has many promising young athletes progressing throughout the various age groups, male and female. These young athletes carry the burden of interclub during the season. It should not be left to the younger brigade and a few senior athletes - regular attendance of all club members will increase the strength of our club. This support is necessary at avenues of competition, SAF, HAF, Regional and Club Nights.

Finally coaching and development continues at Olds Park throughout the year. Our coaching co-ordinator, Peter Tuziak and myself spent many hours each week working with athletes of all ages and all of our club members are welcome to attend any of our training sessions held twelve months of the year.

Southern Zone competition saw only three rounds, Sylvania Waters, Buckle Reserve and Olds Park. Four clubs made up the zone Illawong, Ingleburn, St.George, and Sutherland. See the detailed results for our club's performances. Our club did well on the evening of the Olds Park meet to win the aggregate score for the night. We had a total of 32 athletes on the ground that night but the numbers were poor on our away nights. I hope that our athletes will be willing to travel for next season's competition.

The results of the various state championships were encouraging - particularly those of our younger athletes. Congratulations to our successful track relay teams for an excellent result during the weekend of the age relays at SAF. The outstanding effort of the Mens Under 16 years 4 x 1500m was one of the highlights of the season. Without star runner Tony Auciello our four runners, Leon Leary, Keiran Gallagher, Jason Buckley and Daniel Simone contested a close race throughout and any of five teams looked to have a chance of winning. Daniel Simone's final 400m put the result in our favour.... a brilliant 400m at the end of 1500m. Gold medal winners at various State Championships include Lisa Zammarrelli - 3000m, Tony Auciello - 1500m and 3000m, Clinton Pelham - 100m, 200m and 400m, Belinda Otto - triple jump, Danielle Ferraro 100m and 200m. We also had several athletes not too far from the winners either - see detailed reports for the results. Special mention should be made of Karen Hall - battling injuries throughout the season she leapt 5.66m in Canberra in the long jump, her best effort by far and is showing promise in the heptathlon event.

Finally, the club's first season of summer cross country at Scarborough Park was most successful. Held in the cool of the evening all runners enjoyed the competition and it is to be hoped that the numbers will increase next season.


Cath Williams our Club Captain did a fine job, for as well as being our clubs highest points scorer with 102 points, she always gave a hand in organising the ladies teams and particularly the relay teams each Saturday.

As a combined team we were without doubt the most successful combination in the competition. Our athletes gave their all to reach the finals in 6 of the 7 grades and we finished up winning 3 premierships i.e. ladies "A" and "B" Grades and mens "D" Grade.

The win by our "A" Grade ladies was the first ever,by a team from St. George or Sutherland. We are very proud of the girls for their great effort - they were undefeated throughout the competition.

Our "A" Grade mens team had a neck and neck struggle with Tiger Wests for the entire 2 days competition covering 22 events only to bow out in the 3km steeple, the last event, to go down by 161 points to 157. Many of our girls scored points in this top grade including Anne Manning who was the only undefeated racewalker. Anne had a perfect score winning outright each week to score 63 points. Her contribution in the first event each Saturday i.e. 3/5km walk gave our team a flying start. Anne continually broke her club records throughout the season and she will continue this great comeback into next season.

Danielle Ferraro had a good start to the track season with a personal best in the 400 metres of 57.45s. She scored 31 points before injuries put a dampener on her progress. That is just a slight hiccup Danielle, the enforced rest may be a blessing.

Emeritus Presidents Report

Ladies and Gentlemen,

In 1962 I produced a booklet giving details of the formation of the club on Monday 7/3/1921, together with outstanding performances of members from 1921 to 1962. On this occasion I'm highlighting some of the outstanding promotions involving the club.

Our first big effort was the holding of the 1st Australian Marathon on 27/8/27 under the auspices of the AAU of Australia and the NSWAAA. The race started at Barrack St near Martin Place to Hurstville and finished at the Sydney Cricket Ground. Entries totalling 39, came from every State and New Zealand. The winner was R.McMurdo of Queensland, in a time of 3h 6m 23s.

Later we conducted 3 State Marathons in 1948-49-50 on behalf of the NSWAAA. These started and finished at the Rockdale Town Hall and went to the Botany area. The fastest time was in 1949 with 2h 48m 15s by Rowley Guy of Botany.

The State Novice CCC was first held at Ramsgate on 20/7/40. It started and finished at Ramsgate baths and proceeded through Scarborough Park. The winner was Doug Dickings of Botany with a time of 27m 53.5s. St.George has conducted this event ever since. The Novice was first conducted at Rose Bay in 1911 and was won by C.H. Foster of East Sydney in a time of 33m 21s. Albert Thomas and Jim Bailey both club olympians won the State Novice along with Laurie Whitty & Gary McClean.

Our club had a magnificent year in 1948 when it held 2 International Meetings at Hurstville Oval. Without doubt these were the best the club has ever held since its formation. the first featured Herb McKenley of Jamaica and Lloyd La Beach of Panama. Both these athletes competed at Olympic Games and at different times held world records.

In the first, Herb McKenley performed magnificently running 300yds in 30.4s (Aust record). Lloyd La Beach, not well, was beaten in the 100yds by Bartram of Victoria in 10.2s. The crowd was estimated at 12,000 spectators.

The second featured Fanny Blankers-Koen of Holland who won 5 Gold Medals at the 1948 London Olympic Games. Spectators numbered 14,000 which created a ground record. The crowd covered the cycling track and spilled onto the circular running track. Fanny performed up to her olympic standard when she ran 80 metres hurdles in 11.3s (Aust record) only 1/10th outside her olympic winning time. Marjorie Jackson, later to be a dual olympic champion at Helsinki in 1952, won the 100yds in 11.2s, while Shirley Strickland, also to win at the Helsinki Games in the 80m hurdles, won the 220yds in 25.5s.

We had a great season in 1976-7 with a record membership of 279. Women had not joined our club at this time. There were 10 teams at Interclub from "A" to "U13" and we gained 3 1sts, 3 2nds 3 3rds and 1 5th. Athletes who competed with great success these years were Vin Plant, Laurie Whitty, Bill Bird, Bob Talay, Stephen Longden-Gee, Graeme Cook, Dragon Arapovic and Milo Bodiroza. Our distance athletes had a great season winning 5 teams titles and 4 individual titles in State Championships.

This history supplements that included in last years Annual Report.

Comments on Annual Financial Statements

Over the past five years, the Club's funds have fluctuated as follows -

In 1992-93 Club funds decreased by \$679, and when combined with the decrease for the previous year, show a reduction of \$3,288. The Club needs to monitor its expenses in future years to enable it to preserve its capital. Interest rates have fallen significantly over the past twelve months and although the Club's fixed deposits at 31 March 1993 stood at \$12,282, interest is likely to fall below \$500 in the next financial year.

During the year the Club incurred abnormal expenses of \$1,470 when it incorporated. The other major expenditure during the year comprised assistance totalling \$4,456 to individuals for travelling expenses to compete in Australian Championships and overseas. This is a significant increase over the \$2,650 paid in the previous year, but was offset by donations of \$2,525 received by Clubs in the St George area. Our President Ron Gribble is to be commended for his efforts in appealing to these Clubs for assistance. These Clubs which have generously supported our athletes include the St George Leagues Club, Brighton RSL Club, Brighton Fishermen's Association, Bexley RSL Club, Georges River Sailing Club, Rockdale RSL Club, Penshurst RSL, The Roundabout Hotel at Hurstville, Earlwood-Bardwell Park RSL, Rockdale Businessmen's Club and St George Masonic Club.

Next year McDonalds have entered into an arrangement to sponsor NSW Combined High School Teams to compete at the Australian Combined High Schools Championships, and this should reduce the number of requests by Club athletes for assistance.

Once again David Carlisle has agreed to audit the Club's books in an honorary capacity. His suggestions in ensuring that the Club's assets are properly accounted for, and his dedication to his auditing function are of substantial value to the Club.
