MINUTES OF THE 76th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE ST GEORGE LEAGUES BOWLING CLUB PRINCES HIGHWAY CARLTON ON TUESDAY 24 JUNE 1997.

The minutes of the 75th Annual General Meeting were confirmed on the motion of Dennis Jolliffe seconded Ron Gribble. There were no matters arising from the minutes.

**Life Membership** - Life Membership was conferred on Bob Molloy, Secretary, for outstanding service to the Club. In awarding the medal Dennis Jolliffe the longest serving Life Member present outlined the services rendered as secretary and his assistance in fund raising activities over a 15 year period.

The 76th Annual Report and Financial Statement was presented by the President Albie Thomas. He called for a minutes silence in memory of Alleyn Gainsford, Ken Jenkins and Terry O'Connor who passed away during the past twelve months. He thanked all those members who contributed throughout the year in many different ways pointing out that everyone can be successful at different levels. Fund raising was a major activity as this provided the Club with the ability to assist talented athletes to compete at interstate venues and referred members to the results achieved as shown in the Annual Report with so many records being established. The liaison with St. George LA's provided the avenue for athletes to continue in the sport and many of the records were established by athletes who had come through St. George LA's. To a large extent this was due to efforts of Arthur Peek, Peter Tuziak and Jim Gallagher who provided coaching and created the right environment. The cross country season is seeing more parents competing as well as their children. The cross country season is where most of the fund raising occurs. The track season gave excellent results and saw a number of gold, silver and bronze medals won in championship events at National and State level as well as the achievement of personal best performances. The 75th Anniversary Dinner was very successful with some 150 attending with many old members attending and it raised some \$600 towards the Teams Fund

**Peter Olah** (Mayor Hurstville) thanked the Club for its contribution to the community and thanked those dedicated members who assist without thought of personal gain. He mentioned that Hurstville Council have a policy of providing up to \$200 to under 18 year old sportspersons who gain representative selection.

**Betty Moore** (ANSW Director for Development) thanked the Club for its contribution to the sport and urged that the Club have programmes which take the sport and facilities to the public.

**Dennis Jolliffe** pointed out that the membership was falling which made finances difficult particularly with sponsorship to so many talented athletes gaining representative selection. He thanked Hurstville Council for their financial assistance to the young athletes in the municipality and thanked Alan Staples, Arthur Peek, the Ferraros, Val Moore for their assistance in collecting entry moneys, raffle, canteen, membership dues and also those who assisted at interclub events.

**Barbara Lea** President of the St. George LA's congratulated the Club on its results and that it was good to see the athletes progressing from LA's to the seniors. She thanked Arthur Peek and Peter Tuziak for their coaching activities with LA's

**Ron Gribble** congratulated the junior athletes for their fine effort in breaking so many long standing senior records and commented that the Club was now gaining the benefit of better communications with LA's. He stated that the youngsters had a long way to go in the sport and to take a break if they needed it. There are many competing demands, training social and study. He thanked the office bearers and supported the adoption of the Annual Report.

**Tom Richards** said that he had 25 years in the Club and that it was the best 25 years of his life. He like Alleyn Gainsford loved the sport and that it was always a sport you could come back to.

**Bob Nash** congratulated all on the Annual Report. The Club was down in numbers but not in quality. Welcomed Peter Olah to the meeting.

**Peter Tuziak** commented that some of the facilities we had were substandard and paid homage to two previous world holders present Betty Moore (Hurdles) and Albie Thomas (2 & 3 mile) and observed that the facilities now available and the tracks on which to compete were far superior to those of the past that it was little wonder that records were being broken.

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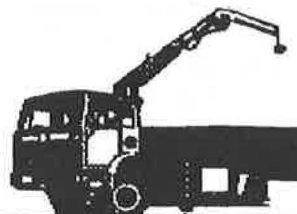

There are three distinct categories into which club members can be placed. These are -

- (a) Open, Veterans and Officials;
- (b) Athletes 16 years and over but under 20; and
- (c) Athletes under 16 years.

In 1997-98 club member numbers rose. This increase occurred mainly in the 16 to under 20 group, which has for several years been low in numbers. There was a pleasing increase in numbers of athletes registering for the summer, and this resulted in some outstanding performances on the track. During 1997-98, the Club received 46 new members and had 125 renewals, compared to 37 new members and 119 renewals for the previous year. 101 members, including 53 athletes under 15 and 18 officials, were members for the full year; 48 registered for the winter season and 22 registered as summer athletes.

## President's Report

Presented to members at the 77th Annual General Meeting held at St. George Leagues Club Kool Room on 23 June 1998.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Over recent years we have seen changes to the athletics scene here in Australia. There has been an emphasis towards the "elite athlete" and the all out pursuit for "gold medals", which seems to be the only goal. Therefore the major funds and sponsorship has been directed to support those programmes. It means that the athletes lower down in the rankings are certainly less well off. At the club level - the nursery of athletics - it is virtually a case of fend for yourself.

Our club is in the "fend for yourself" category whereby we raise all of the funds to conduct our total club activities. It also means that we are responsible for assisting our athletes to travel to National and/or International competition (not held in NSW).

So far Daniel Batman has been the only athlete who has been able to organise some sponsorship - he has a grant from Breville (thanks to John McClean).

During the 1997/98 T & F season we gave considerable financial assistance to our athletes.

For the National Open and Under 20 years Championships in Melbourne we supplied \$150 each to Ursula Rodway, Andrew Franklin, Keiran Gallagher, Sean Culkin, and Daniel Batman. The Under 18/16/14 Championships were in Adelaide, where we provided \$200 each to Daniel Batman, Kevin Bezzina and Brydan Lenne. An amount of \$150 each was supplied to Carly Bartlett, Daniel Batman, Sean Culkin, Alison di Rosa, Phoebe Gunning and Elizabeth Stratford so that they could compete at the All Schools Australian T & F Championships.

There was also the All Schools cross country / National cross country Championships, where we gave \$100 each to Brydan Lenne, Elizabeth

Stratford and Sam West. Daniel Batman was provided with \$200 for a New Zealand tour by an Australian Under 20 years team.

This represents a total of \$2,750 allocated as financial assistance during the 1997/98 season. (in the financial report it is shown in the period the cheque is given).

All of the above money has to be raised by our members. This is where our willing supporters and volunteers "shine like beacons" as they give their help and time. Members volunteer as officials for the Sydney 1/2 marathon and the City to Surf, for which a payment is made for each volunteer.

At the one NSW championship that we host on our home course, the NSW Novice Cross Country, we rely on our volunteers to mark courses, set up the start and finish areas, and act as officials, plus operate the BBQ, the tea and coffee shop, lolly shop and conduct a raffle. It is one of our main fund raising days and it would not be successful without the help from Arthur Peek, Tom Richards, Allen Argall, Alan Staples, Gallagher Family, Joyce & Bob Molloy, John Hudleston, Val Moore & Family, Kay Culkin, Nola Thomas, Norm and Jill Windred, John Irvine.

We received financial help from St. George League's Club, Mortdale RSL Club, Brighton le Sands Amateur Fishermans Club, and Arncliffe Sports and Social Club, plus Gordon Bucton's Butchery donated 200 sausages for the BBQ, and the very generous donations of prizes by John McClean and Breville. We also held a number of social fund raising dinners with the inevitable raffle.

Without these contributions and the time given by our members, we would be unable to help our promising athletes with financial assistance.

We also rely on Bob Molloy our General Secretary, who ensures the club administration runs smoothly, but also volunteers for every activity that we are involved in.

Dennis Jolliffe our Treasurer who not only keeps control of our dollars, but during cross country he is there by 1pm to set up the day, and handicaps the Div 1 races.

Alan Staples our Distance Secretary is also in attendance at Scarborough Park by 1pm to help set up, collect all of our race fees, sell raffle tickets, and is also a volunteer at every function.

Tom Richards - "Mr Uniforms" - "Mr Yes I will attend", and "yes I will help" gives invaluable help to us all.

Arthur Peek is our "Mr Summer Cross Country", is also a coach that helps the young athletes and acts as a very important liaison with Little A's.

Our "Mr Track & Field" is Jim Gallagher who manages our young stars at Homebush, plus he organises the "Gallagher BBQ Team"

In cross country our other handicappers, Stan Donnelly, Julian Scott and Chris Stratford do handicaps with the aim of giving everyone a fair go - though we often hear- "how did I get that lousy handicap"

And of course our "form filling duet" of Coral and Albert Ferraro (Registration)

Let us not forget our "cup of tea Ladies" - and "the refreshment & snacks team" from the Moore's - thanks from us all.

Whilst the T & F season may absorb much of our funds, it is from this small group of young athletes that we reap the majority of our best results, rewards and records. During the last season they have routed most of the club records over various age divisions and events - just check the records section in this report. They have also won or been placed in many National or NSW Championships.

In the very comprehensive report by Jim Gallagher, you will notice the names of Ursula Rodway, Elizabeth Stratford, Alison di Rosa, Carly Bartlett, Brydan Lenne, Daniel Batman, Sean Culkin, Kevin Bezzina, Keiran Gallagher, and Andrew Franklin being regularly mentioned for their performances and records. Let me not forget the other young athletes who are regularly training and trying - just keep it up as your turn at the top will come.

Chris Stratford is a major helper at Homebush, competing as an athlete, and running the scoreboard. But Chris, please no more close calls.

We also had a few "oldies" who performed well on the track. Ros Laver with club records, and places in National Masters events. Our over 70's star, Norm Windred, who won the National Master's races over 100, 200 and 400.

The highlight was the selection of Daniel Batman in the Australian Team for the World Junior Championships (under 20 years) to be held in France.

It is during the cross country season that we have our largest turn out of members for races at Scarborough Park. We cater for all age groups and every standard of fitness, over varying distances. The handicap and scratch races give everyone a chance of a win or place. There is racing for the serious runner or the person just out to keep fit. Everyone has the opportunity to be a winner, whether it be handicaps or fastest times, or point scores, or just against yourself, but the important thing is being involved.

Our members competing at various State Championships of road, cross country & relays, provided us with some good results. We could do much better if we had members enter the events, even if it is just to make up a team so that you are given a chance in those events.

Our "girls and ladies" (select your own category), provided us with 1 First, 2 Seconds and 3 Thirds in State championships. Whereas the "boys and men" managed 2 First, 3 Seconds and 2 Thirds. Well done, but we can do better.

The outstanding Senior athlete in the winter was Sylvia Rose and in the lower age groups it was Brydan Lenne. Our over 40 years athletes also produced a fair share of the above placings.

Winners are not only the athletes that are the best performers at the top level of competition. We can all be winners at various levels, whether it be winning a handicap race, a scratch race, a point score, a Trophy day event, just beating your own times, or it can be as simple as getting to the starting line and enjoying a run, and thankfully it can also be volunteering as a helper. So congratulations to "all of our winners".

At the Hurstville City Council - Australia Day Awards ceremony, Alison di Rosa was awarded with the "Young Sportsperson of the Year". Well done Alison.

**6 - St. George Athletics 98**

The 1997 Cross Country season was a mixture of success and disappointment. The club races at Scarborough Park are continuing to be popular with good fields and competition. Although we are seeing a trend with shorter distances proving to be more popular than the longer distances and consequently the Senior Division is losing runners to Intermediate 1. This exodus may change in 1998 when the programme will change to include only one race over 10kms. The disappointment of the season is the small number of runners competing at NSW Championships. I would like to see healthier spirit developing within the club and see more athletes competing. The red and white uniform is very distinctive and will always be noticed in front of every other club uniform. We need to have greater numbers representing the club, especially with the relays.

The club successes were mainly centred around the veteran runners. The Over 50 Men's team was our most successful team winning four team medals. However, we also gained two medals each with the Over 40 Men's team and the over 45 Women's team. Our regular veteran runners were Dave Patterson, Frank Scorzelli, Vilis Gravitis, John Irvine, Greg Breen, Dave Edwards, Ron Gribble, Bryan Lenne, Kerry Edwards, Susan Lenne, Gail Stratford and Elinor Walsh.

Our best individual Senior runner was Sylvia Rose who was third in the Australian Marathon Championship in a time of 2h 47.09 which is a new club record. Sylvia also came second in the 10km Road Championships at Holdsworthy. We would like to see Sylvia compete in more State events, if at all possible. Dean Degan carried the flag as our most consistent Male Senior runner but needs some support to field teams in the championships.

In the younger age groups, Brydan Lenne was our most successful athlete in winning two U14 State Championships. We have some promising athletes in the club and when we were able to field full teams we had some good results winning two relay events. Young athletes who competed at the State Championships regularly included Amy McDonald, Nicole Jones, Emily Glover, Melanie Buckley, Michelle Buckley, Catherine Buckley, Elizabeth Stratford, Rachael Patterson, Kara Nichol, Kathleen Edwards, Brad Wiblen, Sam West and Michael Edwards.

**1997-8 Track & Field Season Report**

by Jim Gallagher

The format of the club competition changed significantly this season with a return to interclub and not interdistrict as it had been for several seasons.

As a consequence we competed each week as St. George and not as Saucony Sutherland St. George.

Gradings were also changed from A,B,C,&D grades to A,B, Under 18 and Under 16, and pointscores for events were changed as performances were taken over all clubs in each event, not, as previously just over the match between 2 clubs each week.

Athletes found the seeded competition gave them a better level of competition each week. The one disadvantage was that, being a smaller group, we often could not manage to field relay teams. This disappointed some athletes.

Apart from the interclub competition at Homebush each Saturday, there was regular outer ground competition on Saturdays at Sydney Athletic Field, and the popular Waratah series on Friday nights at Homebush. Some of our club athletes once again joined in the St. George LA's competition on Friday nights at Olds Park.

Seven of our younger athletes competed at the Australian All Schools Championships in Brisbane in December. These were Carly Bartlett, Phoebe Gunning, Elizabeth Stratford, Alison di Rosa, Kevin Bezzina, Daniel Batman and Sean Culkin.

There were several very good performances recorded, notably Daniel Batman (1<sup>st</sup> in 200m, 1<sup>st</sup> 400m under 17), Kevin Bezzina (1<sup>st</sup> in 100m, 1<sup>st</sup> in 200m under 15), Phoebe Gunning (2<sup>nd</sup> in 800m, 4<sup>th</sup> in 400m under 17), Carly Bartlett (4<sup>th</sup> in high jump under 15), Sean Culkin (4<sup>th</sup> in high jump, 4<sup>th</sup> long jump under 19), Elizabeth Stratford (6<sup>th</sup> in 3000m under 17).

The Australian Open and Under 20 Championships were held in Melbourne in March and the lower age groups in Adelaide. Andrew Franklin & Keiran Gallagher competed in the Opens, Sean Culkin, Daniel Batman & Ursula Rodway competed in under 20's. Daniel was placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in 400m and Ursula 4<sup>th</sup> in 400m hurdles. At Adelaide, Daniel Batman competed in under 18's, Kevin Bezzina in under 16's and Brydan Lenne in the under 14's. Daniel was 1<sup>st</sup> in 400m, Kevin 3<sup>rd</sup> in 100m & Brydan 4<sup>th</sup> in 1500m.

The NSW Championships were held in February. Athletes who gained places in these championships were Keiran Gallagher (1<sup>st</sup> in 400m) Sylvia Rose (2<sup>nd</sup> in 5000m open) Sean Culkin (1<sup>st</sup> in long jump under 20), Ursula Rodway (1<sup>st</sup> in 400mH under 20), Kevin Bezzina (2<sup>nd</sup> in 100m & 200m under 16) Brydan Lenne (2<sup>nd</sup> in 1500m under 14)

In NSW Multi Event Championships in January, Sean Culkin finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in under 20 mens decathlon & Ursula Rodway was 2<sup>nd</sup> in under 20 womens heptathlon. Both set club open records.

A new young athlete to emerge this season was Kevin Bezzina. Still competing in St. George LA's he became a regular at interclub with the Senior Club putting in many fine performances in 100m & 200m, setting a club under 16 100m record. A foot injury hampered his

efforts in National Championships, but he had 2<sup>nd</sup> place in 100 & 200m at State and 1<sup>st</sup> in 100m & 20m in the Australian All Schools. His potential for 400m has been noted and with only 2 years in athletics he has potential for much further development.

Rachael Quiggan, a former St. George LA joined the club this season but a foot injury side lined her from sprinting for almost the entire season. However she always came to interclub and participated in discus and shot putt in the under 18 division setting a Club under 20 womens discus record. She was always willing to do what ever she could for the Club, ran a 4 x 400m relay leg and was always looking for ways to be helpful. Hopefully, next season Rachael will be able to get back into sprinting where she has a lot of talent.

Two other ex St. George LA's made initial appearance with the Senior Club, Matthew Ayers in middle distance & Steven Eccles in sprints & jumps. Other commitments prevented either from competing regularly, but both showed talent that will hopefully develop with more regular participation.

Daniel Batman had a great season, beginning with wins in 200m & 400m at All Schools Championships and successfully defending his under 18 title in 400m and winning the 200m. He was 3<sup>rd</sup> in under 20 National 400m Championships. He set Club records in 400m under 20 and 200m under 18 and was selected in the Australian Junior team to tour New Zealand. He showed consistent improvement over 4 runs in New Zealand and carried the form back home to continue the improvement. To cap the season he was chosen for the 1998 World Junior Championships to be held in France in July. We wish Daniel success in the World Juniors.

Phoebe Gunning started the season well recording a big PB of 2m 09.5 s in the 800m, a Club senior women's record. Injuries later in the season prevented participation in State/National Championships.

Ursula Rodway, after several frustrating seasons hampered by injury came back to form this year participating in several events but specialising in 400m hurdles. The climax was her 400m hurdles run at the Sydney Grand Prix, finishing 4th and knocking off her previous best in the very good time of 60.24s, a Club senior womens record.

Keiran Gallagher & Andrew Franklin both had good seasons after injuries had upset previous seasons. They ran in the major Grand Prix events - Keiran in the 400m in Adelaide, Hobart, Canberra & Sydney and Andrew ran 400m hurdles in all these plus Melbourne. Keiran was 2nd in the Canberra GP 400m (in which Daniel Batman ran 3<sup>rd</sup>), and Andrew ran 3<sup>rd</sup> in 400m hurdles in Melbourne equalling the Club senior record of 51.28s.

Sean Culkin continued to improve in several events establishing new Club records in under 18 long jump and senior high jump and decathlon.

Elizabeth Stratford continued her progress in the 2000m steeplechase breaking her senior club record by a huge 17 seconds.

Ros Laver turned her hand to Track & Field this season 7 compett regularly at inerclub in discus, shot putt & javelin. She set Club records in womens open discus & shot putt. She finished the season with a 3<sup>rd</sup> in the veteran womens 200m at the Sydney Grand Prix.

Carly Bartlett competed regularly at interclub and championships and continued to improve her high jump performance eclipsing all club records from under 14 through to open women.

Bydan Lenne's commitment throughout the season was rewarded in the National Championships where she ran 800m & 1500m PB's and was well placed.

For Chris Burgess, an injury early in the season would not go away and eventually sidelined him. He hopes for better next season.

Others to compete strongly and contribute to our pointscore were Dean Degan, Chris Stratford, Clinton Pelham. Paul Cotter, Alison di Rosa, Ramon Rumble & Alan McElroy. Clinton & Paul were in our successful State Relay Teams.

**State Relays**

Once again with a small group of athletes the Club performed outstandingly at the State Relays on 29-30 November 1997. We entered teams in open 4x100m, 4x200m, 4x400m, under 20men 4x100m, 4x200m, 4x400m and womens under 20 4x1500m, womens under 18 4x800m. These 8 teams were made up from 8 male & 5 female athletes and gained 5 firsts, 2 thirds and a fourth in finals. The women & under 20 men won all 5 events they entered. Four Club records were set including 2 from the open men. It is encouraging to see the good performances of our teams.

## Club Challenge

The Club Challenge was held over the first 3 competition days of the season prior to Interclub. The second day was washed out. Our Club was comparatively well represented and we performed well. The competition is open to all NSW Clubs, several of which are much larger in T & F than St. George. However we had our best result to date finishing in the top 8.

Over the past five years, the Club's funds have fluctuated as follows -

In 1997-98 Club Funds rose by \$2,642.71. Through careful management, the club has been able to arrest the decline in club funds over recent years. This has been at the cost of not being able to assist our developing athletes as much as we would have liked when they were selected to compete in Australian Championships. This year, we have received little assistance from licenced Clubs in the St George area because of the increase in State Government taxes these Clubs have had to pay. Many Clubs have written to our Club regretfully informing us of these changed circumstances. The Club's Executive has had to carefully consider requests from athletes for assistance, and in many cases, we have had large numbers seeking assistance when Club funds have been very limited. The movement in Club Funds shown above includes the reinvestment of interest of \$835.68 on the Club's term deposits.

The Club's members contributed to fund raising efforts by officiating at the Half Marathon and the City to Surf. Our thanks are given to the many Club supporters and members who have willingly assisted in this and other fund-raising efforts.

Once again David Carlisle has agreed to audit the Club's books in an honorary capacity. His suggestions in ensuring that the Club's assets are properly accounted for, and his dedication to his auditing function are of substantial value to the Club.

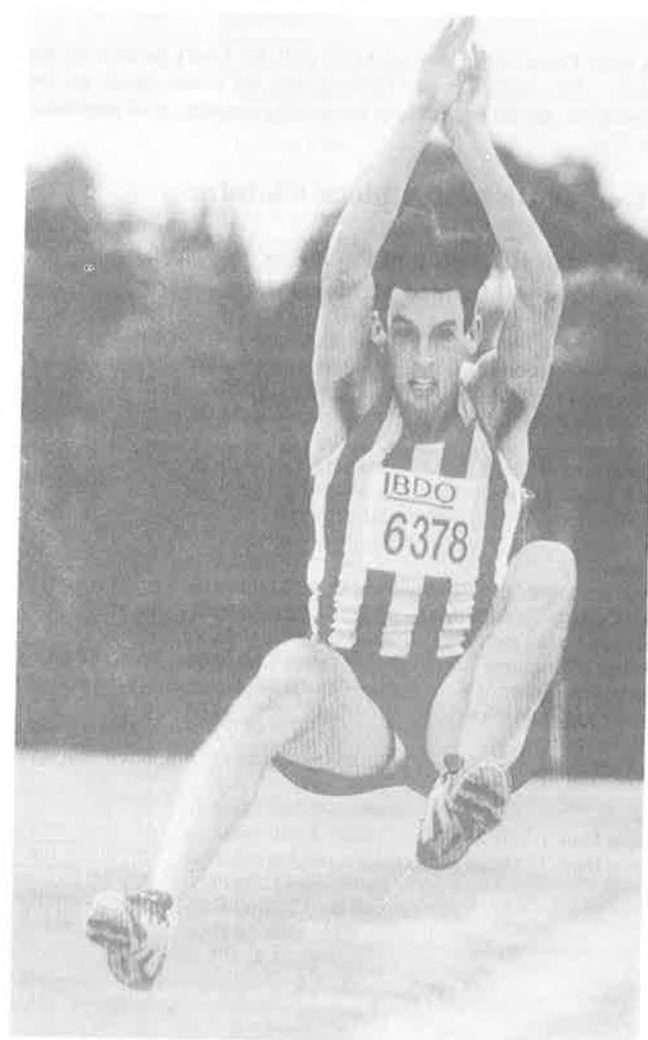
