MINUTES OF THE 77th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE ST GEORGE LEAGUES BOWLING CLUB PRINCES HIGHWAY CARLTON ON TUESDAY 23 JUNE 1998.

The meeting opened at 7.35 p.m.

The President Albie Thomas welcomed the Patron, Vice Presidents, Life Members, Merit Award Holders members, and guests amongst whom were Betty Moore representing Athletics NSW, James Jordan (Mayor Kogarah), Brian Simpson (Mayor Rockdale)

The minutes of the 76th Annual General Meeting were confirmed on the motion of Norm Windred seconded Alan Staples. There were no matters arising from the minutes.

The 77th Annual Report and Financial Statement was presented by the President Albie Thomas. He thanked all those members who contributed throughout the year from the officials to the ladies serving tea and refreshments at cross country. Fund raising was a major problem throughout the community – the Commonwealth Games in Kuala Lumpur was experiencing difficulties. Club fund raising assisted a number of the young athletes to attend national championships. Results from this group were very encouraging – a large number of club records and the women members were outdoing the men. The liaison forged some years ago with St. George LA's was proving beneficial but the older athletes were also producing some excellent results. He thanked the Mayor of Rockdale for their support of the Novice Cross Country Championship.

Brian Simpson (Mayor Rockdale) thanked the Club for its invitation to attend and commented that he used to run with the club back in the 1950's at Hurstville oval. He would try to maintain the support of the Novice

James Jordan (Mayor Kogarah) also thanked the club for its invitation and congratulated the club for its input into the community

Betty Moore (ANSW Director for Development) thanked the Club for its contribution to the sport and commented that it was one of the few clubs which was showing an increase in membership. Athletics NSW was moving forward after some difficult years. She congratulated Daniel Batman on his selection in the Australian junior team to visit France later in 1998.

Bob Nash thanked Albie and his committee and the Rockdale Council for its assistance. He would consider a comeback as the club photographer.

Ron Gribble commented that the Little Athletes were becoming seniors due to the liaison with St. George LA's. It is hard for the juniors to stay in the sport as there wasn't much support to get to the representative stage. The lack of a major sporting facility in the three Council area of St. George with all of the top sportsmen produced in the district was disappointing and inhibited future development of sportsmen in all sports.

Dennis Jolliffe commented upon the number of records and advised that Stan Donnelly after many years as senior handicapper had resigned and called for expression of interest failing which he would complete this years handicapping in conjunction with his Intermediate 1 handicapping. Thanked the Ferraro's, Jim Gallagher, Alan Staples and Kay Culkin for their assistance in fund raising to support the interstate competition for athletes. Wants the older members to actively encourage the younger athletes in passing on knowledge in coaching and training.

Peter Tuziak commented upon the relationship with the St. George LA's and stated that although we didn't have a synthetic track we still had excellent gear and facilities for training and coaching. He stressed that a former Russian three time Olympic gold medal winner in the triple jump was available as a coach (Victor Saneev) and that athletes should avail themselves of his expertise.

It was moved by Dennis Jolliffe seconded by Albert Ferraro that the 77th Annual Report and Financial Statements be approved.

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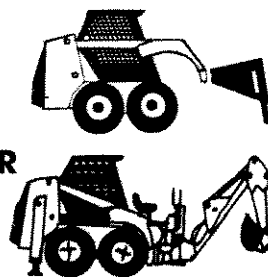

There are three distinct categories into which club members can be placed.

- (a) Open, Veterans and Officials;
- (b) Athletes 16 years and over but under 20; and
- (c) Athletes under 16 years.

In 1997-98 club member numbers fell by 16. This decrease occurred mainly in the 16 to under 20 group, which fell by half. During 1998-99, the Club received 36 new members and had 119 renewals, compared to 46 new members and 125 renewals for the previous year. 112 members, including 54 athletes under 15 and 19 officials, were members for the full year and 43 registered for the winter season only.

President's Report

Presented to members at the 78th Annual General Meeting held at St. George Leagues Bowling Club on 22 June 1999.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This report contains comprehensive reports by our Track Secretary, Jim Gallagher, Distance Secretary, Chris Stratford, Treasurer, Dennis Jolliffe, as well as coverage by Arthur Peek for Summer Cross Country. These reports let you know what happened during the year.

While our membership may be slightly down in numbers, our financial position has improved considerably. This is because we all worked hard to support fund raising. On the down side of this, some of our Track & Field athletes had injuries so were unable to attend National Championships-meaning less call on financial support.

As I stated last year, if we want to spend money supporting our athletes, then we have to raise it ourselves. This is done by our raffles, dinners, meat tastings, chocolate fund raisers, and our volunteers at major fun runs acting as officials. I thank all of those members who have donated their time and energies towards these activities, because without you, we would be much poorer off. During 1998/99 we contributed \$2400 towards financially supporting our athletes, and this is from a 155 membership.

Cross Country did produce some excellent results, with our Under 29 Women and our Over 55 years Men's teams both winning Gold at the NSW relays at Miranda. Sylvia Rose won the NSW 1/2 Marathon, Female division, and was 2nd in the Australian Marathon. Dean Degan was our best Senior Male athlete, whilst Brydan Lenne was the most successful Junior Female. During the winter season we also conduct a point score and fastest times competition, with the most successful normally being those that attend the most regular. I congratulate our 1998 cross country champions, and of course also those that turn up regularly to enjoy themselves. Thank you Chris Stratford for your excellent and comprehensive report.

The 1998/99 Track & Field season report by Jim Gallagher supplies all the details of the years performances. It does report a low turn out by athletes, and also that we had a number or people out with injuries. But there are also positive outcomes with some excellent results--just look

at the Interclub point scores, then check the number of new Club Records established.

Daniel Batman represented Australia at the World Junior Championships and came away with a Gold Medal in the 4x400 metres relay. He was also awarded the St. George Leader - Junior Sports Star of the Year.

Keiran Gallagher continued to improve his 400 times and qualified for the Grand Prix A series, was admitted to the NSW Sports Institute, plus he has been selected in the Australian Team for the World University Games.

Ursula Rodway and Sean Culkin are now in Open competition, both have had injuries, yet both performed creditably. We may not have quantity, but every one of our Track & Field athletes have one thing in common--quality. So well done and better next year.

Arthur Peek again conducted his very successful Summer Cross Country series at twilight, which was well attended. The point scores and fastest times point scores were very keenly contested, with Chris Maver and Jackson Young taking out the honours. This is a very important part of our year as it keeps our winter athletes in touch during summer. Thank you Arthur for the time that you devote running this competition.

Dennis Jolliffe, our Treasurer, has the finances in good shape, but Dennis is also a handicapper, time keeper, and one who opens up each cross country day. Tom Richards is also there to set out the cross country course each week, organises the club uniforms and keeps tab of the annual trophies. There is also Julian Scott, Coral & Albert Ferraro, Alan Staples, Bob Molloy, Chris Stratford, the BBQ-ing Gallaghers, our Tea Lady Committee, Chocolate and meat tasting Kay Culkin, and our volunteer helpers who all contribute to making the cross country season run so well run. It has been a team effort.

I thank everyone who has given their time and efforts in another successful year. It would be remiss of me not to thank our sponsors in John McClean with Breville, and Gordon Bucton's Butchery. They contributed goods used in fund raising.

So now let's look forward to the 1999/2000 season

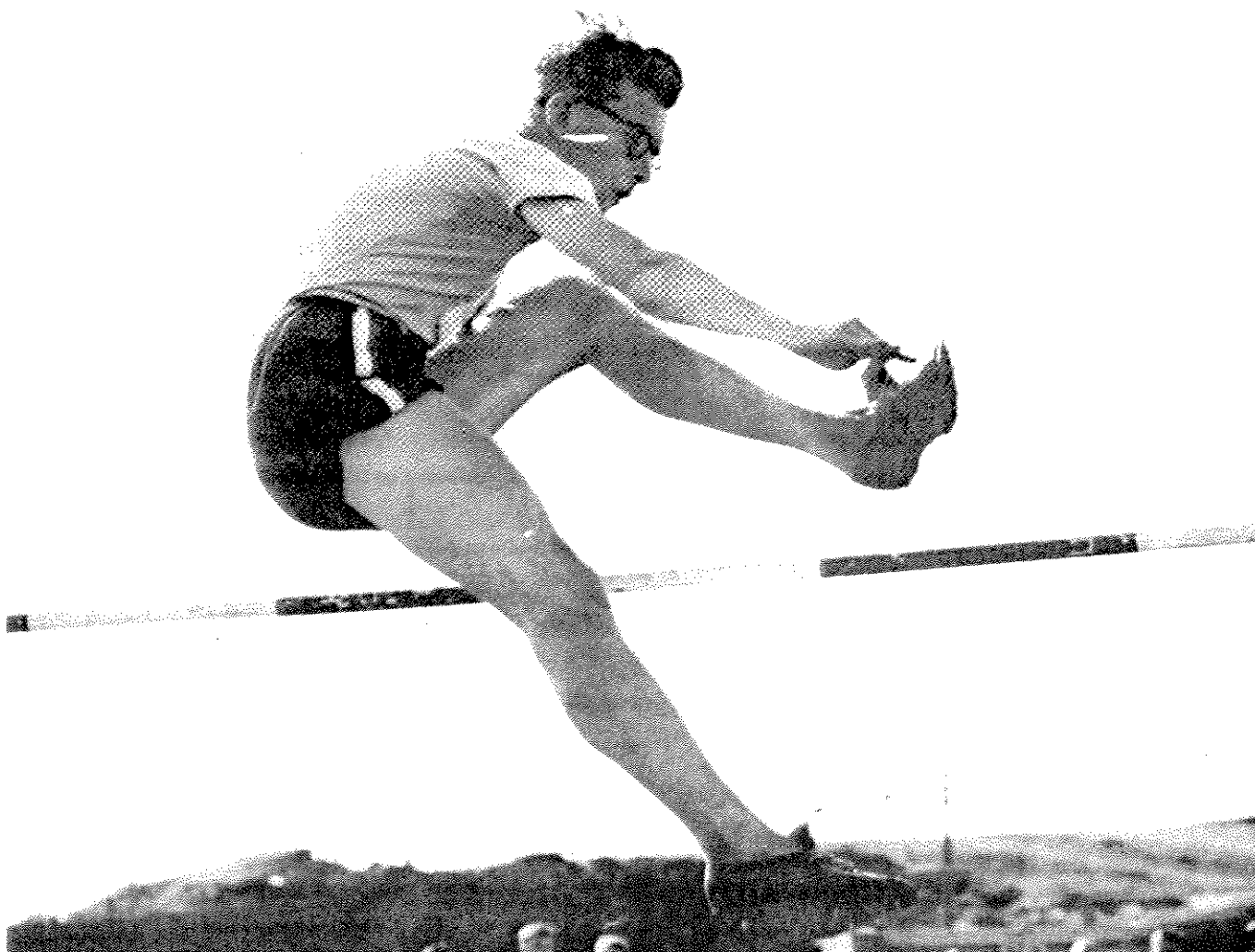

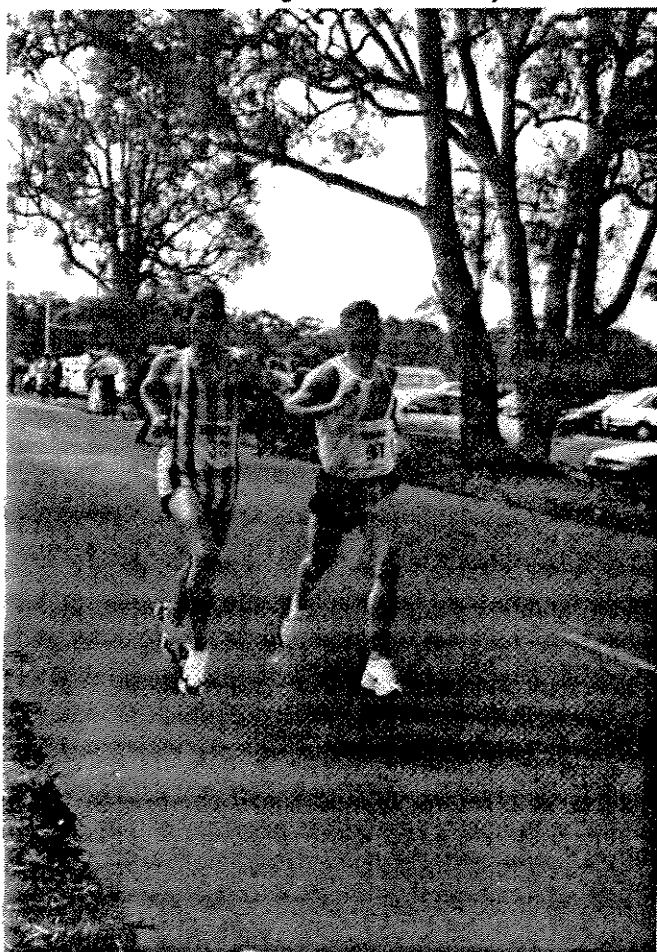

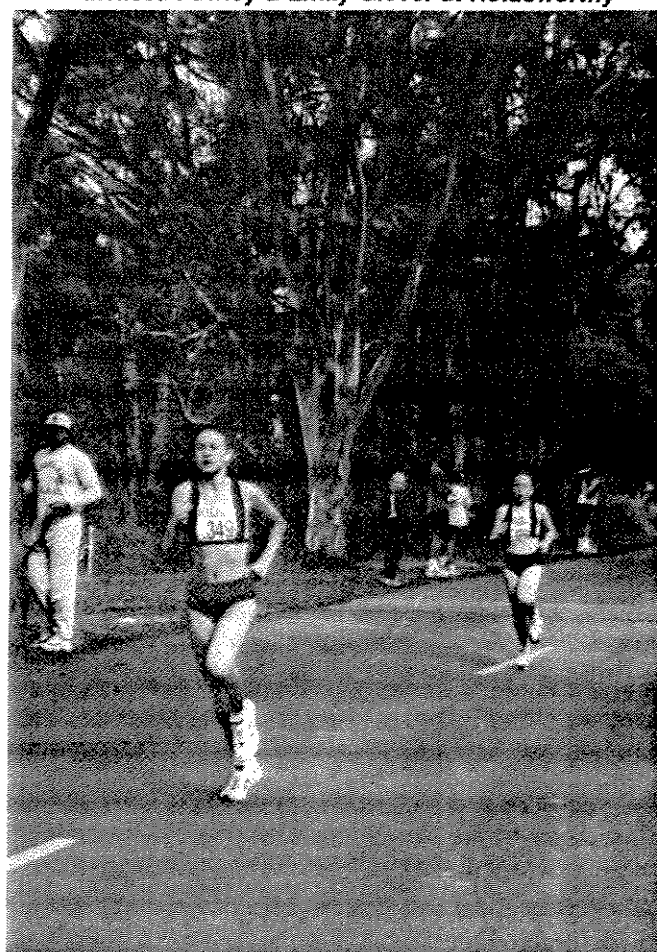

1998 DISTANCE REPORT

The 1998 Cross Country season was another successful year at Scarborough with plenty of good races and competition. However, we could not transfer this success to the championship races and our team successes were few. St George gained two first places and both were at the Cross Country relays at Miranda. St George fielded twelve teams at these relays, which was very pleasing. Elizabeth Stratford anchored the Under 20 Women's team to a win after good legs by Nikki Carter, Catherine Buckley and Melanie Buckley. It was the Men's Over 55 team which provided a stirring finish for St George. The first three legs were run by Dennis Jolliffe, Liam Cadogan and Michael Roberts who had established a small lead. Ron Gribble, who had been battling with health problems, took the "baton" for the last leg and ran at a steady pace for 3 kilometres. In the last kilometre Ron was overtaken by the Kemplar Joggers runner but Ron had decided which team was going to win. With a few hundred metres to go, Ron put in a finishing burst and passed the opposition runner and gave St George the victory. However, the effort left Ron a little worse for wear and caused some concern but after a while he recovered well.

Our most successful runner was Sylvia Rose who won the NSW Half Marathon Championship in a very good time of 75 minutes 16 seconds and came second in the Australian Marathon Championship, Gold Coast, in an excellent time of 2 hrs 39m 29s. Unfortunately, Sylvia suffered injury problems which required surgery. We wish Sylvia a speedy recovery and hope to see her running at her best in the near future.

Dean Degan was our best senior male runner and represented our club in most of the NSW Championships as well as representing NSW in the Australian Championships. Other senior runners who performed well in Open company were Frank Scorzelli, Jim Owen and David Patterson but are also in the veteran category. Jason Buckley, David Page and Shane Causer also represented the club at Championships but unfortunately we lacked the numbers to field Senior Open teams at most events.

Brydan Lenne was our most successful junior runner winning two state titles and performing well each week at club level. We have a number of promising young runners but unfortunately there are insufficient runners to field more teams at championships. We look forward to watching the progress of our younger runners and I'm sure we'll see some champions emerging. However, we are all champions, in our own right, when we compete at Scarborough and other venues and I hope many runners will continue to enjoy Cross Country.

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**1998-9 Track & Field Season Report
by Jim Gallagher**

The 1998-9 season was not one of our best, with low turn out to interclub each Saturday, and low participation in State and National championships. A number of our talented young athletes were sidelined through injuries for the entire season. These included Kevin

Bezzina, Phoebe Gunning and Clinton Pelham. Rachelle Quiggin made a comeback to sprinting early in the season but was then sidelined for the latter part. She still managed to be prominent in the interclub pointscore and set a club age record in the 100 metres.

Despite the scarcity of red and white, there were a number of positive aspects to the season. Daniel Batman who was selected in the Australian team for the World Junior Championships in France had a great tour. In lead-up meetings in Germany and Belgium he produced big PB's and club records in 100, 200 and 400 metres. He ran the individual 400 metres at the Championships and was a member of the Australian Gold Medal 4x400 metres team.

Sadly upon his return he was plagued with injuries which severely interrupted his Australian summer season.

Kieran Gallagher had some fine results, with consistent performances at interclub and good PB's in 200 and 400 metres. He qualified for the Grand Prix A series in 400 metres, and was 5th in G.P point score leading into the Brisbane final. Injury caused his withdrawal from the final. His best performance was 2nd in the Hobart G.P and he registered wins against all but two of Australia's 400 metre competitors. He was admitted to the NSW Sports Institute, and gained selection in the Australian team to the World University Games in July 1999 in the 200 and 400 metres.

Ursula Rodway was selected for the Canberra Grand Prix 400 metres hurdles, but suffered a severe ankle injury which put her out of action for several weeks and limited her preparation for State and National championships.

Sean Culkin was once again a consistent performer at interclub in sprints and jumps leading the club pointscore.

Carly Bartlett again improved her high jump performance elevating the club record she holds right through to the senior women.

Ros Laver added the open women's shot putt to her list of club records in senior women's throws.

Belinda Martin having her first track season performed very well, with improvements in 800 and 1500 metres during the season. She also participated in the steeplechase, 400m hurdles and 3km and performed well in all. She is a very keen athlete with potential for further improvement next season.

Once again some St. George Little A's made their entry into senior ranks and performed well. Jane Brotherton set club age records in long jump and performed well at State and National championships in Under 16 heptathlon. She was 3rd in National championships with a huge PB of 4001 points. Kimberlee Green's performance in State Under 14 championships was outstanding, being placed in 1st in three events, 100, 200 metres and shot putt, with a club age record in the shot putt. Matthew Ayres had a good season, settled into senior ranks with improvements in his 400, 800, 1500 metres and 3km distances. Elizabeth Stratford started the season with little training under her belt, but performed consistently and improved throughout the season, being well up in pointscores. Brydan Lenne went through a growth period where she had to struggle, but her determination did not leave her, and although away for a large part of the season, was well up in the pointscore and was placed in two events at State Championships. Newcomers Robert Muir, Zani Apostolovski and Aaron Dawson also helped keep the red and white visible at interclub, Robert being a consistent competitor.

We struggled to fill teams for the State Relays, and did not have the success we have enjoyed over recent years. We could field only seven teams from eleven entered, and managed only one place in finals.

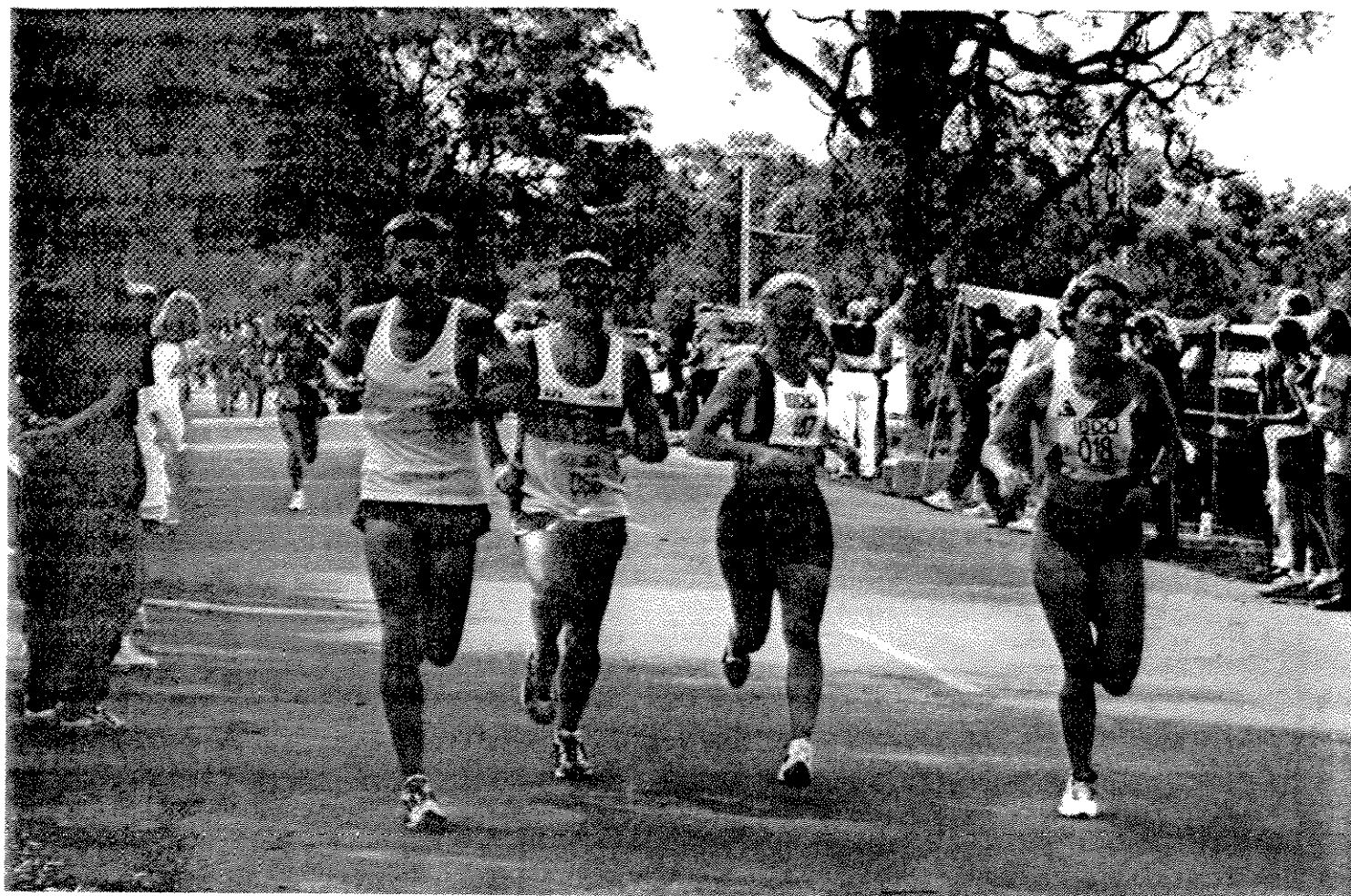

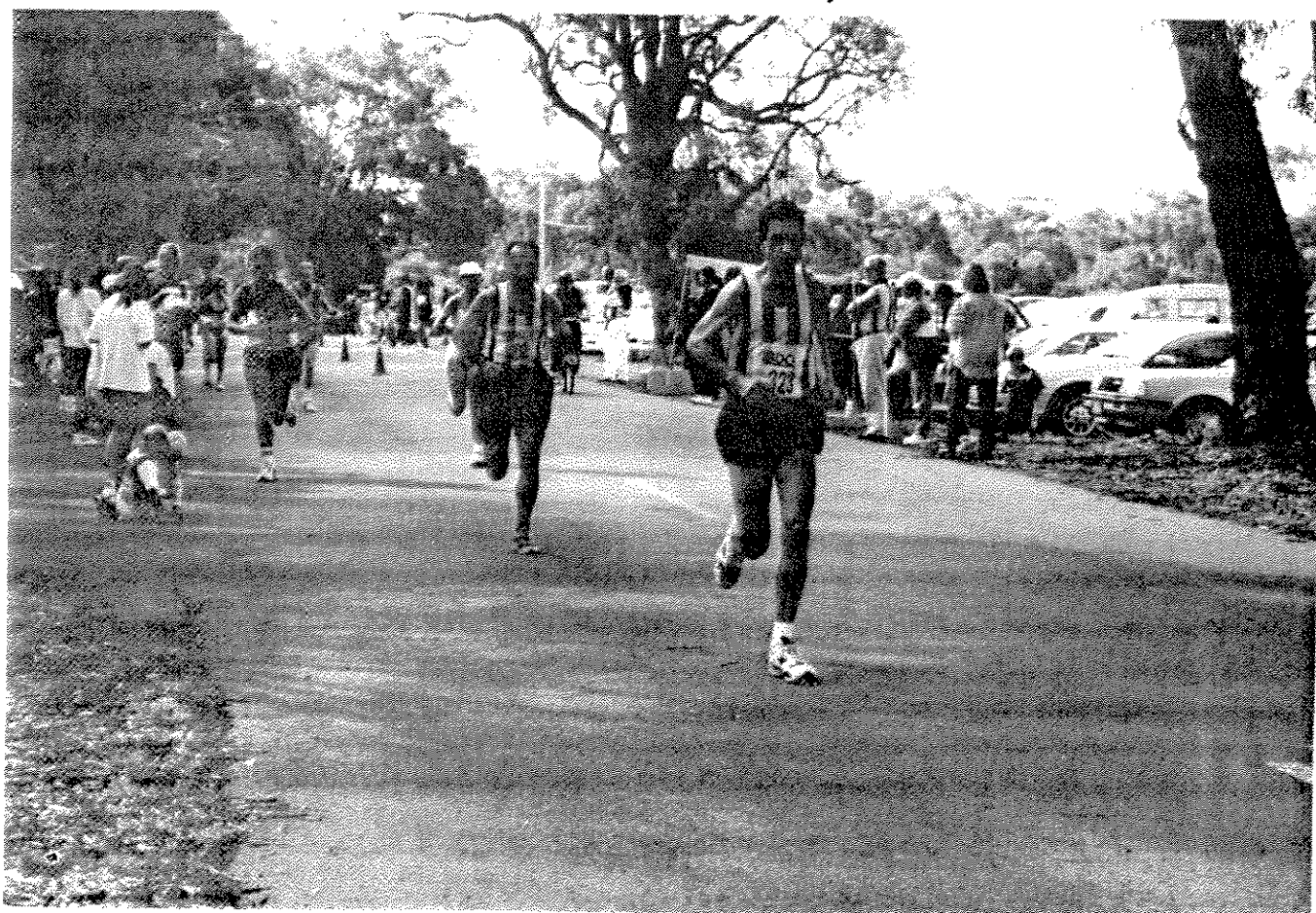

In 1998-99 Club Funds rose by \$3,847.28. Through careful management, the club has been able to build up its funds by more than \$6,000 over the past two years and to arrest the significant decline (mainly in the Teams Fund Account) which had occurred in prior years. The Club contributed \$2,400 to individual athletes in 1998-99, and has been able to do this from donations received and a wide variety of fund raising activities, including meat tasting, sales of chocolates, fund raising dinners and a supply of officials to the City to Surf, Half Marathon and Marathon. This has been possible only through the efforts of Club supporters and members who have willingly assisted in this and other fund raising efforts. Particular thanks to Kay Calkin in this regard. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Club members who have provided assistance to me as Treasurer. Alan Staples, as Race Secretary, Coral and Albert Ferraro as Registrars, and Tom Richards who has handled Club Uniform purchases and sales have been of great help. This year, a former Club member Michael Hanrahan has taken over as honorary auditor. Michael is very aware of the Club's activities and his agreement to act as honorary auditor is appreciated very much.

Obituaries

A tribute to the late Harry Gould

Harry Gould who died on 2 August 1998 aged 82 years came from a family well known in athletics over many years. He was a remarkably versatile track and field athlete, competing in sprints, hurdles and jumps. His best performances were between 1938 and 1940 - 100yds in 10.0s; 220yds 22.3s; 440 yds 49.6s (he won a NSW 440yds title); long jump 23ft 4 1/2 in; triple jump 45ft 7in. He was a handy 880yds runner and held the senior club record for 220 and 440 yds hurdles. He represented Australia in the 1938 British Empire Games in Sydney being placed 4th in the long jump (23'4 1/2") just behind fellow St. George athlete Basil Dickinson.

A tribute to the late Reg Jolliffe

Reg died on 1 May 1999, aged 86 years. For many years Reg was an active official of the Club being Track Secretary and Distance Secretary during the 1950's. He officiated at the 1956 Melbourne Olympics. He was in his younger days a professional sprinter competing in the west of NSW and Victoria. His interest was passed onto his three sons all of whom competed for St. George - Rod, Lindsay and Dennis who is still competing at cross country.

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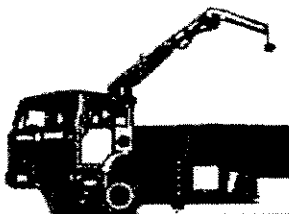
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
