MINUTES OF THE 78th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE ST GEORGE LEAGUES BOWLING CLUB PRINCES HIGHWAY CARLTON ON TUESDAY 22 JUNE 1999.

The meeting opened at 7.35 p.m.

Present 34 members and guests - see attached list

The President Albie Thomas welcomed the Life Members, Merit Award Holders members, and guests amongst whom were Barbara Lea St. George Little Athletics, Ron Crawford (and congratulated Ron on his Queens Birthday Honours) representing Athletics NSW and Athletics Australia.

Apologies – Mick Frawley Mayor Hurstville, Marion Smith Deputy Mayor Hurstville. Bob Nash Patron, Ron Gribble, Peter Tuziak, the Lenne family, Elizabeth Stratford.

Adoption of the minutes of the 77th Annual General Meeting were confirmed on the motion of Albert Ferraro seconded Norm Windred. There were no matters arising from the minutes.

Merit Award – A merit award was to have been made to John McClean but he was unable to attend. It was awarded for outstanding service to the Club in connection with the provision of prizes for raffles and trophies as well as achieving 15 years continuous membership.

The 77th Annual Report and Financial Statement was presented by the President Albie Thomas. He commented that there were detailed reports by the various officials in the Annual Report and all he was doing was drawing on highlights. The Club raised its own funds by engaging in various activities and he thanked all those members who supported and initiated the fund raising activities. The funds were used to assist athletes to compete at National and International championships. Mention was made of a donation of \$250 from Arneliffe Scots at a recent fund raising dinner for Kieran Gallagher.

**Barbara Lea** President of the St. George LA s thanked the Club for its invitation and stated that more needed to be done to encourage the LA's under 15 to move to senior ranks. She wished the Club well for its forthcoming season.

Ron Crawford (ANSW Director) thanked the committee and athletes for their contribution to the sport. The scene is changing in Athletic Clubs in that it was hard for clubs to maintain membership. The Association will need to help clubs and in this area is looking at something along the lines of "Sport Hall Athletics" where the younger athletes compete in larger halls. The SAF would be available for all athletes a so called "Golden Eagle" series (to get away from the notion that it is a Eastern Zone competition). The cost of running athletics is quite a problem and sponsorship and Government assistance is essential. All Clubs appear to be suffering from a dearth of the middle group of athletes 20-35. There were many young and old athletes but small numbers in between.

**Arthur Peek** stated that the process of rebuilding was continuing and was showing results with the younger ones coming through to the senior ranks. St. George officials are to the fore in Interclub competition. He congratulated Kay Culkin for her efforts in fund raising.

**Alan Staples** stated that it was a good report and that the officials deserved to be thanked. He congratulated the prizewinners and commented about the age gap from 20-40. Help is always welcome and it is sometimes surprising at the range of skills which members do have.

Dennis Jolliffe stated that it was a successful season in terms of performances. Thanked all those people who had assisted him during the year, Ferraros, Kay Culkin, Alan Staples and Albie Thomas. He reminisced about the primitive conditions under which he competed as compared to today with the "Fosberry Flop" technique in high jumping and high jump bags all of which had not been invented when he competed in jumps. Even in those days the same problems existed – lack of senior athletes. Club finances are in good shape and the Olympics offer an opportunity to gain athletes from heightened interest.

It was moved by Bob Molloy seconded by Dennis Jolliffe that the 78th Annual Report and Financial Statements be approved.





There are three distinct categories into which club members can be placed. These are -

- (a) Open, Veterans and Officials;
- (b) Athletes 16 years and over but under 20; and
- (c) Athletes under 16 years.

In 1999-2000 club member numbers increased by 14. This increase occurred mainly in the Open, Veterans and Officials group which increased by 14. There was an increase of 5 in the 16 to under 20 group, and this was offset by a fall of 4 in the under 16 group. The increase in the 16 to under 20 group is welcome, but it is still disappointing that other interests and commitments in this age group result in lower numbers competing in athletics. During 1999-2000, the Club received 53 new members and 116 renewals, compared to 36 new members and 119 renewals for the previous year. 112 members, including 50 athletes under 15 and 12 officials, were members for the full year and 48 registered for the winter season only.

#### President's Report

Presented to members at the 79th Annual General Meeting held at Syd, Frost Hall Hawthorne St Ramsgate on 24 June 2000.

#### Ladies & Gentlemen

I am pleased to report that we have had a successful 1999/2000 season. Our membership increased slightly, whereas some clubs experienced a decline. Club finances are also in good shape. Our athletes improved many of the club records with excellent performances. Daniel Batman has been outstanding during the season with Olympic "A" qualifiers over 400 metres, so we are all now keenly watching his progress and announcement of the Olympic Team. Then to put "the icing on the cake", our club was awarded 1 of the 30 special medals from the International Olympic Committee, which had been given to the Sun Herald City to Surf Race. The race had been awarded special status for the Olympic year, and the 30th running of the event. Our medal was for more than 20 years of volunteer services provided by our club members.

We are very fortunate to have dedicated officials who have given their time, and have presented such excellent reports. Chris Stratford for distance season, Jim Gallagher for the track and field season, Arthur Peek for summer cross country, Dennis Jolliffe for finance, and Bob Molloy for the Annual Report. We are very grateful to all of our volunteer workers who assist on all club days during the winter and summer seasons. Without their help, we could not survive, nor help our athletes in competition. To every volunteer, no matter how small or large a job you perform, THANK YOU.

Sponsorship was supplied by John McClean (Breville), Gordon Bucton's Butchery with sausages on Novice Day, and our Terry

O'Connor Christmas Mile race with membership subsidies.

During the winter season you will notice in the report, that success is gained by those athletes that compete on a regular basis, to gain points and experience. Dean Degan gained 3rd place in the NSW Runner of the Year by racing regularly in the required races -- well done Dean. Our female athletes also had a very successful season with 10 medals in NSW championships, and our male athletes with 5 medals. All of the club championships, point scores, and fastest time awards were keenly contested, so we congratulate all the winners and placegetters.

Track and field was supported by more athletes, and they put up some great performances -- just check the number of new club records established and season best performances. Jane Brotherton was virtually a 1 person team with a huge point score during the season. Daniel Batman was the outstanding performer. But he was supported by our other promising athletes. David Evans ran a top class 3000 metres time. Our club applauds all of the club athletes that turned up regularly to compete at interclub, and to those that competed at State and National level. Thank you Jim Gallagher and Kaye Culkin for supporting them, and to Suellen Quiggin, get well, we need you.

Summer cross country plays an important link between each winter season as it provides competition for those not wishing to compete on the track. Thank you to Arthur Peek for conducting this important facet of club competition. Again the results show that the regular attendees obtained the best results in the competition.

It has been my pleasure to serve you and lead an excellent Executive team. I also thank every person that that helped us get jobs done during the year and make the running of the club a team effort. We have a good base to build further, so let us all look ahead to the Olympic Year, and better performances from all.

#### 1999 DISTANCE REPORT

The 1999 Cross Country season was more successful than the previous year with a continued healthy competition at Scarborough and an improvement at the NSW Championships. Once again, we had most athletes at the Cross Country Relays, held at Miranda, when we fielded seventeen teams. St George gained four medals at this championship including a first for the Women's Over 55 3 X 4km team, which included Maureen Cadogan, Elinor Walsh and Leslie Pisch. The Road Relays were not so successful as the Cross Country Relays but we had some highlights. Frank Scorzelli willingly backed up for a second relay leg when he ran the first leg of the Open 4 x 5km race after previously running the first leg of the Over 45 4 x 5km race. Frank's second run was only 38 seconds slower. Adrian Player also ran a leg of the Open team and by fielding a complete team; Dean Degan was able to run the third leg of the team (Dean's preference), which gained him points for the Distance Runner of the Year. Frank and Adrian's club spirit makes my job a lot easier.

The Novice Championships, held at Scarborough Park, earned the club both individual and team success. St George has a very good record at this championship and this year was no exception. St George fielded three Women's teams and the lead team of Brydan Lenne, Belinda Martin and Lisa Hopkins gained First place in the teams. In the Men's race, Dean Degan gained third place after just failing to hold off a fast finishing Kembla Joggers athlete. During the race, Dean had been well positioned during the race and we had hoped he might have posted another win for St George. However, this did not eventuate. If we look at the results for this year Dean's name is noticeable in all championship races and is an improvement on his previous years' efforts. Well done, Dean, on a successful year and also gaining Third in the Distance Runner of the Year for 1999.

Our veteran athletes continue to perform well and it is with a certain degree of sadness that a few of them are forced to reduce their commitment due to health problems. I can think of Ron Gribble, Dennis Jolliffe and Greg Breen who have cardiac problems and I wish them well for the future and hope that their memories will be sufficient to satisfy their competitive urge.

A highlight of the season was the performance of the Under 12 Girls. Not only did they win medals but also we had good numbers. In the Cross Country Relays, we fielded three teams and there were good fields in all the other Under 12 Girls events. Well done Averill Wilson, Emma Millett, Ariel Bray, Sally Mae, Jenna Maynard, Rachel Mullane, Camille Wilson, Laura Bray and Bryelle Wilson. In the higher age groups, we saw good performances from Emily Glover, Melissa Pawley, Brydan Lenne, Vanessa Orklin and Kara Nicholl. 

#### 1999-2000 Track & Field Season Report by Jim Gallagher

Participation at Interclub by St. George athletes was considerably higher than the previous season with some 30 athletes competing. Numbers were fairly evenly divided among men and women.

It was pleasing to see a number of new young athletes making the transition from LA's into the senior ranks, and performing extremely well.

A number of our newer young athletes, especially the women, are multi-talented and put in excellent performances in jumps, throws hurdles and sprints.

Overall, near 30 new Club records were set, as well as excellent results at State and National Championships.

Daniel Batman was the outstanding athlete of the season, overcoming the problems of the previous year and performing consistently in the top bracket nationally throughout the season over 400m. He was consistently 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> during the G P series, 3<sup>rd</sup> at Nationals, ran 2 Olympic "A" qualifiers, broke Club senior records in 400m and also in the 200m for electronic recorded time. Daniel was one of 2 Australian 400m representatives in test matches in South Africa where he performed excellently. He had a long season with lots of top competition but performed consistently well from start to finish and is well placed for Olympic selection in 400m and 4x400m relay events.

We wish him well over the coming months.

In the Open Division, Belinda Martin performed consistently well, rewarded with 2<sup>nd</sup> in the State 1500m, and Ursula Rodway lowered her Club record in 400m hurdles while David Evans set a Club record in 3000m. Both were selected in GP events.

In the age divisions, several of our athletes put in excellent performances at State and National Championships as indicated in the T&F details, and in All Schools National and State Championships. Brydan Lenne, Kimberlee Green, Kristie Pemberton, Jane Brotherton, Carly Bartlett, Chris Barakat, Columba Zenari were all placegetters in these events.

At State relays we had 9 entries in open and over 40 men, senior and Under 18 women . We were stretched to fill senior men's teams. Results are in the T&F details. Our women's 4x1500m comprising B. Lenne, B. Martin, S. Rose & P. Gunning won gold. Once again S. Culkin, K. Gallagher & K. Bezzina were the backbone of our men's open teams, supported by S. Moseley, D. Batman, & A. Stojkovski. U. Rodway, P. Gunning, J. Brotherton, C. Zenari, C. Bartlett, B. Lenne, B. Martin, S. Rose covered the womens events. R. Sharp, M.Stojkovski, V. Gravitis & A. Peek formed the over 40 mens team.

The State Relays is the one event in the season where we are competing for the Club, and in some cases meeting each other for the first time, and so has a special significance.

Suellen Quiggin suffered a serious illness which prevented her being prominent as an official each week. We are happy that she recovered sufficiently to make some appearances at the track late in the season. We missed her dedicated efforts each week and hope that she will be fully fit again in the future. The efforts of Kaye Culkin, our other dedicated official was once again appreciated over the season.

In previous reports we have been remiss not to mention the tremendous, behind the scene, efforts of Vilis Gravitis, our records officer who keeps wonderful, detailed records of every performance by our athletes. We are fortunate to have his services.

The format of Interclub this season did not solve our main problem of relays. Being a small Club we often have athletes missing out because we cannot form relay teams with our associated clubs. Also the random association of clubs for [point score does not produce any team spirit or striving for points. This re-emphasises the importance of the State Relays day.

In 1999-2000 Club Funds rose by \$995.80. Through careful management, the Club has been able to build up its funds by more than \$4,000 over the past two years and to arrest the significant decline (mainly in the Teams Fund Account) which had occurred in prior years.

The Club contributed \$2,500 to individual athletes in 1999-2000, and has been able to do this from donations received and a wide variety of fund raising activities, including meat tasting, sales, fund raising dinners and a supply of officials to the City to Surf and Half Marathon. Once again, Michael Hanrahan has acted as honorary auditor. Michael who is a former Club member has been extremely diligent in his duties and his contribution is appreciated very much.


#### **Obituaries**
