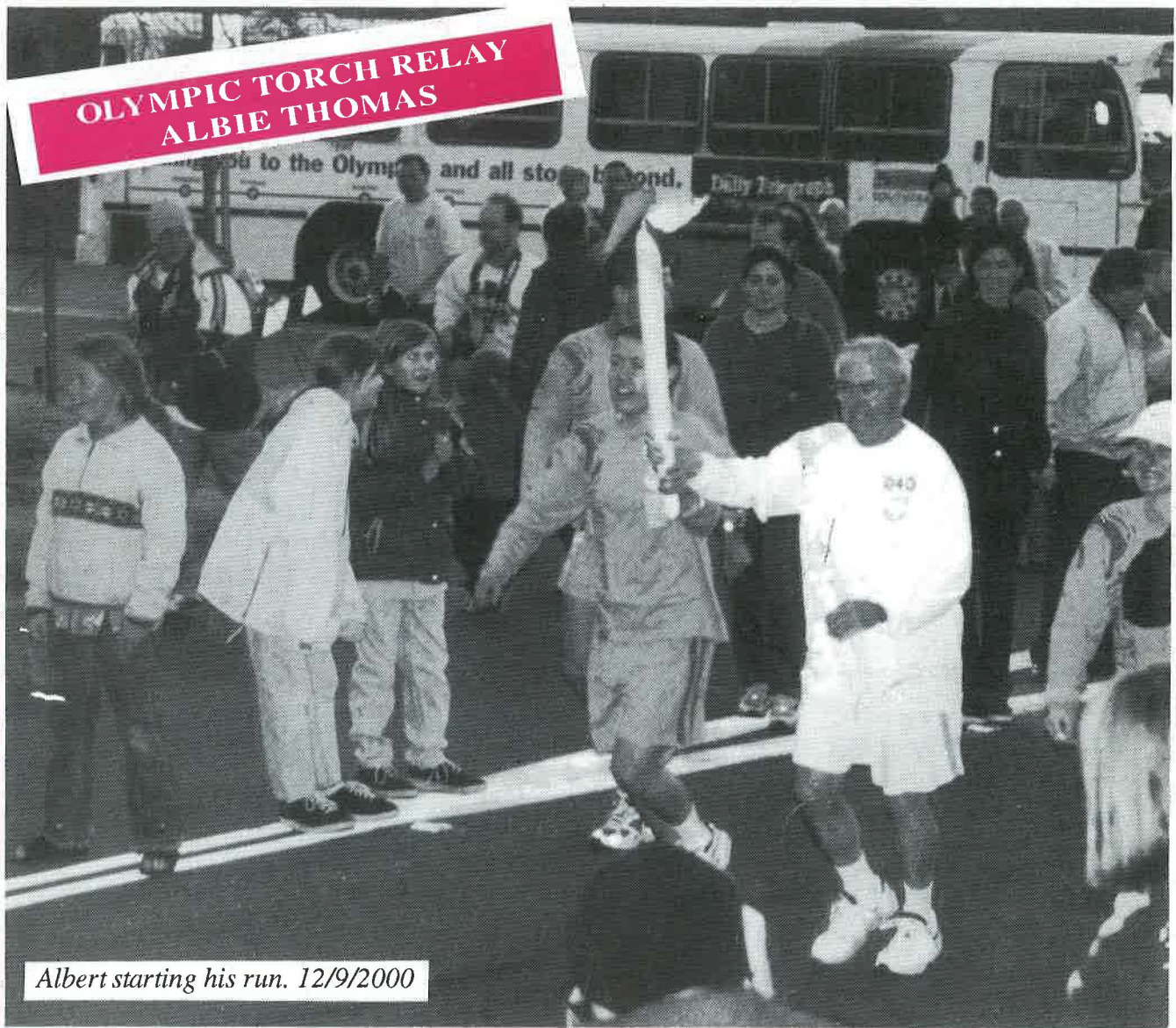

MINUTES OF THE 79th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE SYD FROST HALL HAWTHORNE ST. RAMSGATE ON SATURDAY 24 JUNE 2000.

The meeting opened at 3.05 P.M.

Present 64 members and guests - see attached list

The President Albie Thomas welcomed the Life Members, Merit Award Holders members, and guests amongst who were Lynne Whatman and Julie Upton of the St. George Little Athletics, Ron Crawford representing Athletics NSW, and Athletics Australia and Phillip Sansom Mayor of Hurstville.

Apologies – Geoff Hedge Mayor Rockdale, Sam Witheridge Mayor Kogarah, Dennis Jolliffe (overseas), Coral Ferraro

The order of proceedings was changed to permit of the presentation of two (2) awards to Daniel Batman who had athletic commitments

Adoption of the minutes of the 78th Annual General Meeting were confirmed on the motion of Albert Ferraro seconded Jim Gallagher. There were no matters arising from the minutes.

The President Albie Thomas presented the 79th Annual Report and Financial Statement. He stated that there were detailed reports by the various officials in the Annual Report and that the financial position was good. Membership had increased at a time when other clubs were experiencing declines. He drew attention to the fact that the Club was a recipient of a special award which acknowledged the contribution the Club had made to the City to Surf event over the 29 years that it had been conducted.

Phillip Sansom (Mayor of Hurstville) thanked volunteers and their work for the good of the community and extended his best wishes to the Club and offered assistance if required.

Ron Crawford (ANSW Director) commented upon the increase in membership at a time when there were so many competing sports and the fragmented organisation of Athletics. In this latter regard Athletic Australia was seeking to takeover marketing strategy and junior development. Athletics administration is changing and there is an intention to create a National Register of athletes instead of each State maintaining their own. People will resist change but it is inevitable if the sport is to progress. He thanked the committee and members for retaining and increasing membership.

Bob Nash (Patron) stated that it was a magnificent Annual Report and the Club represented something fine in the community for younger members.

Ron Gribble commented about Daniel Batman's and Ursula Rodway's being some of the few that had progressed through from LA's and deplored the use of drugs in all sports.

Ray Russell stated that the Port Hacking LA's were encouraging their members to continue in the sport with St. George.

Julie Upton (StG. LA's) commented that it was good to see the St GLA's coming through to senior ranks and performing so well.

Chris Stratford mentioned that St. George now had a web site (www.sgdac.org) and asked about the format of the next winter programme.

Alan Staples Suggested that members be prepared to help the three (3) executive who work fulltime throughout the year while some are only involved for part of the year. He mentioned Peter Tuziak's involvement in providing coaching for the younger athletes. The Annual Report provides the link between track and field and the cross-country athletes

Moved Arthur Peek Seconded Peter Tuziak that the annual report and financial statements be accepted.

NOTICE TO ADVERTISERS

There are three distinct categories into which club members can be placed. These are -

- (a) Open, Veterans and Officials;
- (b) Athletes 16 years and over but under 20; and
- (c) Athletes under 16 years.

In 2000-2001 club member numbers increased by 5. The composition of most age groups remained static, although it is pleasing to see increases in age groups of some of the older teenagers. During 2000-2001, the Club received 76 new members and had 98 renewals, compared to 50 new members and 119 renewals for the previous year. 116 members, including 67 athletes under 15 and 12 officials, were members for the full year and 58 registered for the winter season only.

also handicaps 2 of our cross-country race divisions. Jim Gallagher gives us lots of his time as our T & F Secretary, as well as attending most track events to organise our athletes. Chris Stratford has done an excellent job as our Distance Secretary, as well as handicap and recording duties. Alan Staples our "bag man" at cross-country, ensures we all pay our race fees and buy raffle tickets. Julian Scott, the king of the under 12's, does a great job organising and handicapping our nursery group. Kay Culkin, produces our meeting minutes, officiates at T & F, and always helps at fund raising functions. Coral & Albert Ferraro serve on our executive, as well as being our membership registrars. Our oldest active competitor, Tom Richards, controls our trophy awards, opens the hall on race days, and marks out the courses. "Mr Summer Cross Country", Arthur Peek, does a fantastic job organising this competition. When Stan Donnelly had to resign as timekeeper, we were extremely fortunate that Gail Stratford volunteered to undertake this very important role. I give a "special" thanks to Gail for the professional way she has undertaken this role. Without these people, and other members, volunteering their valuable skills and time, to help, then we would not function as well.

The 2000 cross-country season saw our club score a unique double, with Belinda Martin winning the Female Distance runner of the year, and David Evans taking out the Male Distance Runner of the year. They are both fine role models for our members. We had success in the relays and team events at the NSW championships, especially the under 12 girls and the under 14 boys.

In the 2000/2001 T & F season, our team may have been small, but they certainly did not lack quality. The highlight was our club gaining another Olympian, with Daniel Batman, being selected to compete in the 400 metre event at the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games. In the recent Grand Prix series, we had Daniel Batman, Belinda Martin, Ursula Rodway, Blair Martin and Lachlan Chisholm compete with distinction. Jane Brotherton was selected and competed in the Sydney Youth Olympic Festival. We also congratulate our finalists and placegetters in the NSW and Australian T & F championships. Congratulations to our members who created 23 new club records during the year and to those who have won Annual Awards.

Financial assistance of \$1,175 was given to athletes to attend various competitions. In addition we pay full registrations for athletes meeting certain criteria. The Christmas mile group also paid a number of part registrations for younger athletes. We can only do this while we put in the effort to raise funds. Our most generous donor, John McClean, is now unable to offer the raffle prizes. Gordon Bucton, again donated the sausages for the BBQ on Novice day.

The Sydney 2000 Olympic Games provided us with a great sporting spectacle. Who will forget seeing the Olympic Torch Relay passing through our area. Let us now all work to make our club even better in 2001/2002.

Our club really appreciates the relationship we have with both St. George and Port Hacking Little Athletics Centres. We welcome their athletes to compete with us during cross country, and when they reach the age limit, to compete with seniors.

2000 DISTANCE REPORT

The 2000 Cross Country season was highlighted with winning both the Men's and Women's Distance Runners of the Year awards. The winning athletes were David Evans and Belinda Martin. David and Belinda were both consistent and successful. David won the 10km Road Championships, the 12km Cross Country Championships and the 8km Cross Country Championships as well as being the fastest 10km runner at the Novice Championships. Belinda was a consistent performer throughout the season and although she didn't manage a championship that looks a distinct possibility in future seasons.

In addition to David Evans, St George was well represented by Blair Martin, Dean Degan, Saxon Moseley and Damon Harris. At the Crest, St George finished first and third (David Evans and Blair Martin) and it was good to see the distinctive red and white colours leading the field. Dean Degan was a consistent performer and finished the season with the club's fastest marathon of 2hr 30m 59s at the Tokyo Marathon when he finished ninth. This was marginally faster than Damon Harris who had a time of 2hr 31m 10s at the Cities Marathon. David Scorzelli competed alone in the Under 20 age group and also competed as an Open competitor in the Cross Country Relays. David is a good solid performer and it will be interesting to see how he competes as an Open runner.

Our veteran athletes continued to perform very well and St George won four Over 45 team events with the men winning three. The successful athletes for the Men's Over 45 were David Patterson, Jonathan Charles, Frank Scorzelli, Mendo Stojkovski and Noel Theophile. Maureen Cadogan was successful individually by winning the Over 55 titles at Nowra and the Crest as well as helping the Over 45 Women's team win at the Crest. Other veteran runners who competed were Marilyn Kinchin and Kerry Edwards who made up the winning Over 45 team at the 8km Cross Country Championships at the Crest.

Isaq Ali joined our club during the year and he teamed up with Adrian Player, Jadran Vlaicevic, Shane Larsen and Kynan Hall to lead the U14 relay teams to a gold and silver. Isaq has represented the club well and performs at a high level each time he competes for St George. Let's hope that injuries do not curtail that natural talent that he has. Isaq anchored the victorious Under 14 team at the Cross Country Relays. The silver medal was gained at the Road Relays at Cordeaux Dam and although Isaq was catching up to the Illawong runner the

finish line came too soon and the team was beaten by one second. Shane Larsen competed for the Under 14 team but can still represent at Under 12 and we will watch his progress with interest and hope that he is not lost completely to his other sporting interests.

The Under 12 Girls finished the season with three team medals and the club was well represented by Emma Millett, Averill Wilson, Rachel Mullane, Jacinta Doyle, Katrina Bitezniak, Camille Wilson, Ashlee Meades, Alice Holcroft and Laura Bray. Congratulations girls and we hope to see you progress further in years to come.

2000-2001 Track & Field Season Report

The track & field season had an early start for those preparing for Olympic Trials in August. Five St. George Athletes competed in the trials. Daniel Batman continuing good form from the previous season was 2nd in the 400m final and gained selection for the Olympics in 400m & 4x400m relay. Congratulations to Daniel for this fine achievement at 19 years of age. Belinda Martin also continued her good form and was placed 2nd in the women's 1500m. However her time did not qualify for Olympic selection.

In the first round of the 400m at the Olympics, Daniel sustained an injury which forced him out of further competition, which was a great disappointment after an excellent preparation.

Due to the Olympics, the domestic season started several weeks later than usual, and participation in the early rounds of interclub was low. It seems a post Olympic recovery phase was occurring.

A change in club groupings saw St. George once again teamed with Sutherland, which was a much better arrangement than the previous few seasons. The team, called Sydney South, was one of seven which competed over 11 rounds, including finals. We won all 3 women's grades and were placed 2nd, 3rd, & 4th in various men's grades. Thirty-six St. George athletes competed to varying degrees, fairly equally divided between men & women.

Once again, a number of young talented athletes, mainly from St. George LA's joined the senior ranks. These included Dorian & Nicholas Kipriotis, Rowan Hooper, Andrew Jhavery, Keryn Butler, Zenique Giampietro, Adriana Daleris, Zoe Pelbart & Louise Hamer. The coaching efforts of Peter Tuziak with young athletes is being rewarded by the number moving into senior ranks. A number of established athletes also joined our ranks including Lachlan Chisholm, Blair Martin, Stephen McGuigan, Matthew Sinclair, David Heslop, Shannon Brogden. All these athletes broadened our participation in throwers and jumps as well as running events. We also re-established some of our former strength in middle distance events.

At State Relays we were unable to field strong teams in many senior events, and had to scratch some teams on the day due to lack of available athletes. However, 11 teams competed gaining 1 gold, in women's Under 18 4xHigh Jump, and 1 silver in men's 4x1500m Under 14. Further results are below.

Several of our athletes competed in the Grand Prix Series, Daniel Batman dominated the GP 400m with several 1sts, & 2nds. Other to compete were Belinda Martin with a 3rd in 1500m, Ursula Rodway with a 4th & 5th in 400mH, Blair Martin with two 5ths in 3000m and Lachlan Chisholm in 1500m and 800m.

Several athletes competed, and gained places in State & National Championships. A full list of results follows. In addition, Jane Brotherton was selected for Sydney Youth Olympics Festival and was 5th in High Jump.

Several of our younger athletes were also successful in Australian All Schools Championships early in the season. Once again, the Club assisted financially, athletes who were chosen to travel interstate for national championships. Once again Kay Culkin acted as an official at NSW athletes meetings including interclub, and Vilis Gravitis kept records of all participation by St. George athletes during the season.

Overall, the season was successful with more St. George athletes participating, and Olympic selection and several top performances in State & National Championships.

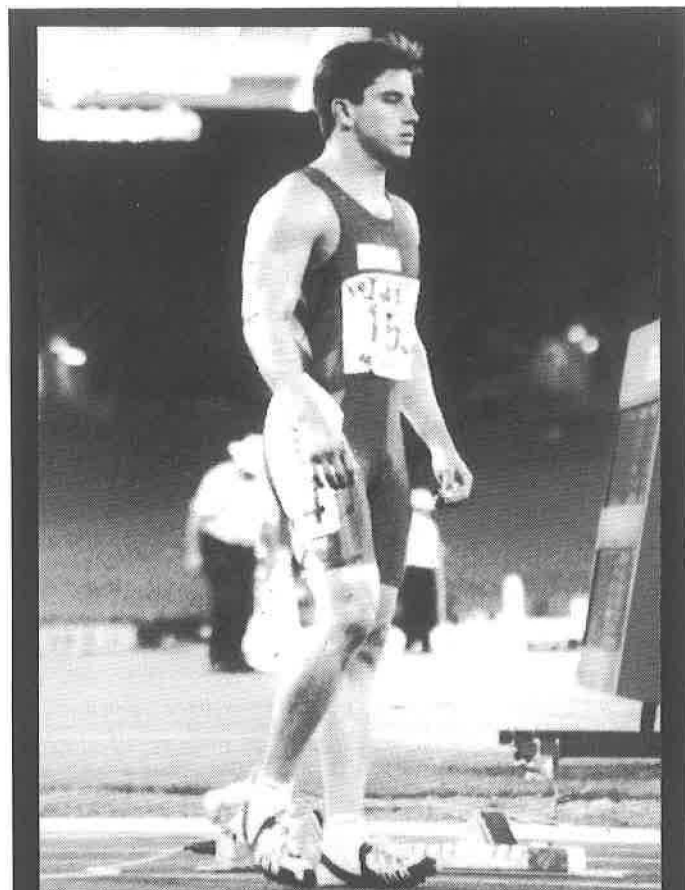

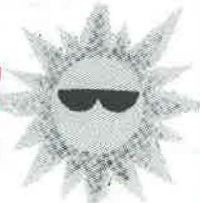
