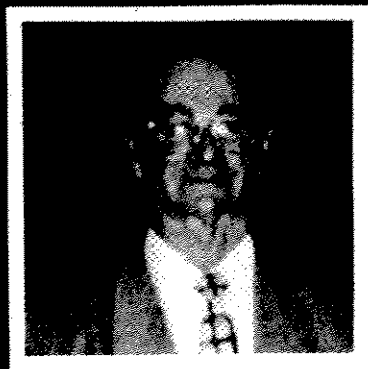

MINUTES OF THE 80th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD AT THE SYD FROST HALL HAWTHORNE ST. RAMSGATE ON SATURDAY 23 JUNE 2001.

The meeting opened at 3.00 P.M.

Present 77 members and guests

The President Albie Thomas welcomed the Life Members, Merit Award Holders members, and guests amongst whom were Lynne Whatman and Julie Upton of the St. George Little Athletics, John Patchett CEO Athletics NSW and Shaoquett Moselmane Mayor of Rockdale.

Apologies – Bill Pickering Mayor Hurstville, Sam Witheridge Mayor Kogarah, Dave Chisholm, Norm Windred, Phoebe Gunning, Albert Ferraro, Michael Roberts

The order of proceedings was changed to permit of the presentation of two (2) awards to Belinda Martin who had other commitments. Belinda received the Robert Nash Trophy for the most improved senior athlete, and the Ron Gribble Trophy for the Open Grades Track & Field aggregate points score. Belinda was also the female distance runner of the year for Athletics NSW.

Adoption of the minutes of the 79th Annual General Meeting were confirmed on the motion of Allen Argall seconded Jim Gallagher. There were no matters arising from the minutes.

The 80th Annual Report and Financial Statement was presented by the President Albie Thomas (moved Bob Molloy that the report be approved and drew attention to a replacement page which was stapled at the last page of the book – the Receipts & Payments Statement had been omitted in the printing). In doing so he drew attention to the detailed reports by the various officials in the Annual Report and that the financial position was satisfactory. Membership increased slightly which was against the trend experienced generally by other clubs. He thanked members of the executive for their contribution and to others who assisted in club administration such as Tom Richards who looked after the club uniform and maintained a follow up of club trophies, Gail Stratford who stepped into the timekeeping vacancy, donations of prizes by clubmember John McClean and to the provision by Gordon Bucton of meat for the Novice Day. He drew attention to the financial assistance provided to members who competed interstate and to members who met certain criteria for payment of their membership or who received a subsidy for membership. He commented upon Dennis Jolliffe's 37 years as treasurer. He commented that there was a flow on from St. George LA's and that the younger members had created some 23 records.

He stated that there was an item to be mentioned in General Business which could significantly effect the Club's future.

The presentation of merit awards to Nola Thomas and Chris Stratford acknowledging 15 years continuous membership and service to the Club (Nola for social activities and Chris for handicapping and the creation and maintenance of the Club's web page) then took place.

John Patchett (CEO ANSW) commented upon St. Georges' increase in membership at a time when others were declining contrary to expectations after the Olympic Games in Sydney. He commented that Athletics NSW were undertaking a strategy for increasing the retention rates for young athletes. He thanked the committee and members for retaining and increasing membership and for the standard of club administration.

Lynne Whatman (St. G. LA's) commented that it was good to see the St G LA's moving into the senior ranks and performing so well.

Shaoquett Moselmane (Mayor of Rockdale) indicated that the Council wanted to help the Club develop and mentioned the issue which the President had indicated would be raised in General Business in that although there had been a move to grant exclusive use of the Syd Frost Hall to a Model Railway group there was a rescission motion and that the matter would be discussed at the next meeting of Council on 27 June 2001 at the Arncliffe Scots. Certain councillors were unaware of the effect upon the Club and that the Club had been using the area for over 60 years.

Dennis Jolliffe (Treasurer) mentioned that this year was a special year for him as it marked the completion of 50 years membership, 37 of which were as Treasurer. He briefly outlined his initiation to cross country in 1951 and provided a short history of the Club's use of Scarborough Park from a small army hut to the present hall which was erected by the National Fitness Council (NFA) with donations from the various users one of which was this Club. He felt that an amicable solution could be found with the Model Railway for continued use of the Hall. He seconded the adoption of the Annual Report and Financial Statements.

At the end of Dennis Jolliffe's comments Bob Molloy made a surprise presentation of a plaque acknowledging Dennis's 50 years membership and 37 years as Treasurer.

Peter Tuziak commented that there was a good influx of athletes from LA's and he was coaching both junior and senior athletes and the support of the executive was appreciated. The web page had induced seniors to return to athletics and some of his squad had the potential to represent the State and maybe Australia. The support of the executive to athletes was most welcome.

General Business Albie read a letter dated 14 June from the Manager - Leisure Services Rockdale City Council to the effect that the Council had approved the exclusive use of the Syd Frost Memorial Hall to the Australian Model railway Association and that the Hall would not be available for the use of the Club from January 2002. He had replied to the Council stating that the Club had received no prior notification that the proposed action was contemplated and requested reconsideration. Mayor Moselmane responded that a rescission motion had been lodged and that the Club could arrange for a speaker to attend the Council meeting of 27 June at 7.00pm.

Election of Officers

Bob Molloy reported that written nominations had been received for all positions and that an election was not necessary. The Executive recommended that there be a change to the position of Patron (Bob Nash felt that he wasn't in a position to do justice to the position) and there were changes to the senior vice presidents and other vice presidents. Albert Ferraro stood down to make way for Dean Degan to come onto the executive.

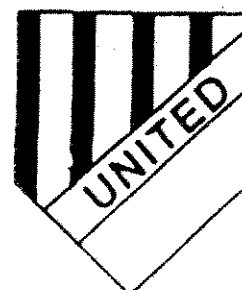

In 2001-2002 club member numbers increased by 2. The composition of most age groups remained static. President's Report

Ladies & Gentlemen,

This Annual report is recommended reading. It is a very comprehensive analysis of the 12 months activity of all of our members. The secretaries have spent considerable time listing the results for the whole year. There are many excellent performances shown, but also we must not forget those that did not excel with wins or places, the important thing is to compete, enjoy the sport, and improve the whole person.

Time – is something that we all say we are short of, yet we have many members who find time to give freely to our club. Think of how much time and effort our general Secretary, Treasurer, Track Secretary, Distance Secretary, Minute Secretary, Handicappers, Timekeepers, Registrars, Coaches and other officials give to this club, so that we can all benefit by having an operational club. It is given freely, with pleasure and enjoyment.

Money – is an item that we would all like to have more of, and it is something that this club cannot function without. Governments are supplying millions of dollars to sport, but it stays in the Elite programs, very little or nothing gets to the club level. All of our funds are raised by registration fees, race fees, raffles, dinners, chocolate sales, volunteer's officials for the City to Surf and Sydney ½ marathon. From funds raised, we assist athletes attending National championships, provide registration fees to selected athletes, and provide trophies. Thanks to Gordon Bucton's butchery for donating the 150 sausages for the Novice BBQ.

Winter season is when we have the most members compete and it is also when we raise the majority of our funds. We had a superb season, winning the Men's A grade competition, as well as the under 12 years boys, the over 55 years women, and our under 12 years girls were second on a count back. These results, were only obtained, by our runners turning up in large numbers at all championship events. We also had numerous places in the various road, relay and cross country championships. In the Sydney, NSW and National marathon championships, which were conducted in the same race, Damon Harris was first and Mustapha Takieddine was second. This is a very unique result with these 2 members placing 1 and 2 in 3 separate championships, a result we are not likely to see repeated. Mustapha also came second in the distance runner of the year competition, losing by 1 point. He also won 5 club championships. It was a fantastic season by all of our runners. Ray Russell has introduced many young athletes from Port Hacking Little athletics to our cross-country season.

Track and field season is when a greater variety of events are offered. It is also when we have less members competing, but we do have lots of quality, and the number has grown due to excellent encouragement by coaches and the summer officials. We are fortunate to get an excellent flow on from St. George little athletics, with that club and coaches developing some very fine young talent. Peter Tuziak has liaised and helped encourage many to join the club, as has Dean Degan introduce many senior distance runners to the club. In competition we combine with Sutherland club which is an excellent arrangement. Zoe Pelbart was outstanding all season with her javelin throwing, lowering club records, and winning State and National titles. Look at our single person scoring machine in women's A, B, and C grade, Lauren Bartlett, who scored 366 points, or approximately 20% of the total. Similarly in the men's we had Chris Barakat score 529 points, or 20% of the total. There were also others that turned up any competed in many events, and scored highly. We have some outstanding young athletes, keep it up. Belinda Martin had an outstanding year, scoring points in A grade, lowering club records, as well as 1st place in the Open 5k and 3rd place in the 1500 at the NSW championships, as well as having an excellent winter season. Please keep working hard, focus on what you want to achieve, go for it, as you only get back what you put in. It is just plain hard work, there is no magic formula. **Summer cross-country**, conducted by Arthur Peek, was also another very successful season. This competition is an important part of the year, as it bridges the time between winter season, catering for those that do not race on the track. Thank you Arthur for your time and efforts in organising this competition.

What you learn in training and athletic competition, setting goals, regular training, competition, dedication, being consistent and honest with yourself, will remain with you throughout life. Do not be tempted by drugs, it is cheating and being dishonest to yourself.

Congratulations to everyone on a very successful year and thank you to those that volunteer help or offer to help as volunteers throughout the year.

2001 DISTANCE REPORT by Chris Stratford

St George won the Men's A Grade premiership after a good tussle with Randwick-Botany. St George was declared premiers after the final event, the Marathon Championship, on a count-back. Many runners played in a part in winning the premiership. The core runners, Blair Martin, Damon Harris, Mustapha Takieddine, Dave Evans, Dean Degan, Saxon Moseley, Lachlan Chisholm, Chadi Elashkar and Hafid Allam teamed together well and we won many team medals. The two outstanding runners were Damon Harris and Mustapha Takieddine. Damon's running improved noticeably in the second half of the season and he ended the season on a winning note by winning the Sydney Marathon (NSW and Australian Champion). Mustapha was a very consistent and well placed performer and his name appears as club champion for five events. For his consistency and good performances Mustapha nearly won the Male Distance Runner of the Year. He came second by 1 point.

The A Grade Premiership would not have been won if we had not fielded a team in the Long Distance Relays. St George came 5th and the two points gained were invaluable. Many of the good runners were unable to compete because of injury and a clash with the Australian Half Marathon Championships but St George fielded an eager team of runners, namely, Frank Scorzelli, Kim Delaney, Chadi Elashkar, Isaq Ali, Mustapha Takieddine, John Charles, Tim Gayton, Jim Owens, Brad Pendergast and Adrian Player. It was a fine effort and I hope we can field a team next year with more of our senior runners. The day was enjoyable and runners commented on the good course.

St George's other premiers were the Under 12 Boys and the Over 55 Women. Luke Hamer, Gerard Gayton, Shane Larsen, Jackson Young, Ben Law, Robert Patterson and Thomas

Delaney formed the nucleus of the Under 12 Boys team. Well done boys and let's hope the successes continue in years to come. The Under 12 Girls finished the season with the same highest number of points as Sutherland but lost on a count-back. Averill Wilson, Kayla Jarvis, Stephanie Beck, Rachel Mullane and Katrina Bitezniuk were consistent runners in this age group.

Other young runners that showed good form during 2001 included Bridey Delaney, Louise Hamer, Dianna Hardy and Emma Millett (Under 14 Girls) and Isaq Ali, Adrian Player and Shannon Delaney (Under 16 Boys). We had many young runners competing at Scarborough and State Championships and no doubt we will be seeing good performances from some of those that I didn't mention. I encourage all runners to seek their own goals but most of all enjoy what you are doing. However, a word of advice, to young runners. I firmly believe that running more than one race on Saturday afternoon does not help a young runner's development. A young runner should run one race well and learn the art of racing. Also, avoid running with injury or illness and have the occasional day off, especially a week before a big race.

The veteran runners continued to show good form and St George won a number of team medals and individual age category medals. Runners who performed well included Frank Scorzelli, David Patterson, Mike Lawson, Jon Charles, Kim Delaney, Mendo Stojkovski, Liam Cadogan, John Irvine, David Edwards and Maureen Cadogan.

Last but not least, are the club runners who come to Scarborough Park each week to enjoy a Saturday afternoon run. The friendly rivalry between runners of similar ability is evident each week and the equality of the handicap system allows any runner to end up as a winner. However, aren't we all winners with the great facilities at Scarborough Park and the good sense to participate in good healthy activity each week.

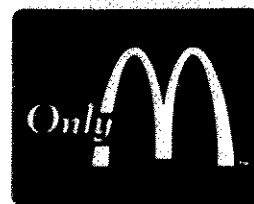

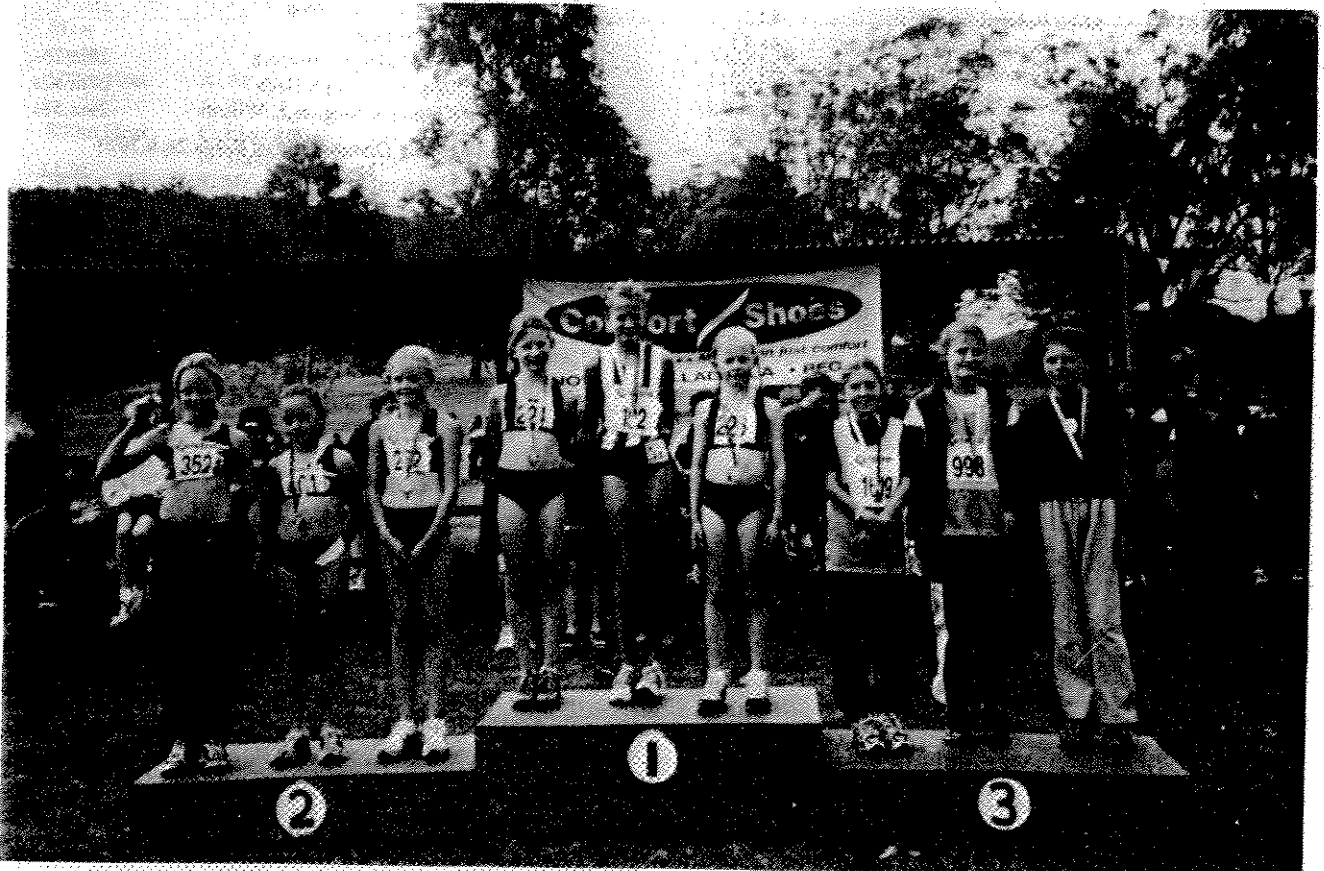

2001-2002 Track & Field Season Report

St. George again combined with Sutherland to form "Southerners" in a 6 team inter-district competition.

St. George turnout was very good this year, with 43 athletes competing. This has grown steadily from 3 years ago when the number was 16. Points scored by our athletes were also very high, making a strong contribution to the Southerners total.

Once again a number of new young talented athletes came on the scene as well as a number of more experienced athletes. Most of them came from Peter Tuziak's training group and the strengthening of our middle distance numbers was aided in particular by Dean Degan and Saxon Moseley promoting the club to training colleagues. Another pleasing aspect of this season was the growth in club pride, athletes taking an interest in and supporting each other, sitting together, and keen to participate in relays especially in running as 4 St. George athletes, in which our Sutherland partners were very understanding. In fact the combining with Sutherland has always worked well to both clubs' satisfaction. Two sets of brothers, Chris and Matt Barakat and Dorian and Nick Kipriotis between them scored a huge number of points, the Barakats in a variety of events and the Kipriotis' in throws. The strength of our middle distance group, especially men's was indicated by 6 of the 8 top men point scorers in A grade, as well as the top A grade woman being in this category. Similarly, 5 of the 6 top point scorers in men's B grade were middle distance.

Other notable inter-district performances included the strong A grade performances by 14 year old Zoe Pelbart, who broke the club's javelin records from under 16 to Open. Jacinta Doyle, 11 and Peter Gregoriou 14, showed great potential in the 400 metres. Kimberlee Green, Carly Bartlett, Ariel Bray, Shannon Delaney among others had strong performances

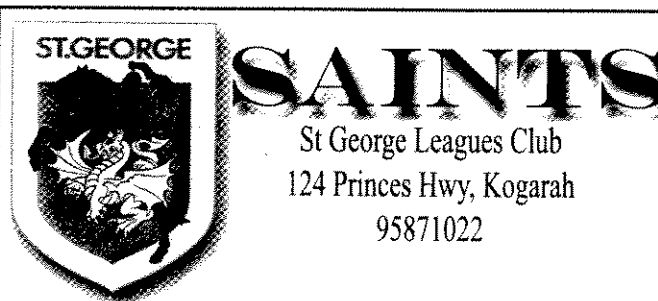

Zoe Pelbart (U16) 1st Javelin, Emma el Gawley (U14) 3rd shot put & discus, Louise Hamer (U14) 3rd triple jump.

Performances at National Youth Championships included; Zoe Pelbart 1st U16 and U18 javelin, Chris Barakat (U18) 3rd in 110m hurdles, 6th in long jump, Peter Gregoriou (U16) 5th in 200m hurdles, Matt Barakat (U16) 5th in heat 100m hurdles, Ariel Bray (U16) 10th heptathlon.

The National senior championships were delayed until April.

We fielded 18 teams in State Relay Championships, gaining 2nd in Open mens 4x1500m & U14 womens 4x800m 3rd in U18 womens 4x400m, U18 men 4xlong jump and U18 4xshot put. In Telstra A series competition, which is the former grand prix series elite national competition, the following athletes competed; Nabil Adamou recorded 3 2nd and a 4th in long jump. Belinda Martin recorded a 2nd in 5000m. Damon Harris and Blair Martin were unplaced in 5000m. Nabil Adamou's 2nd place in Melbourne broke the club's second longest held record, by Basil Dickinson in 1938. During the season Nabil also recorded a 15m plus triple jump, a half metre behind Dickinson's longest standing club record in 1935.

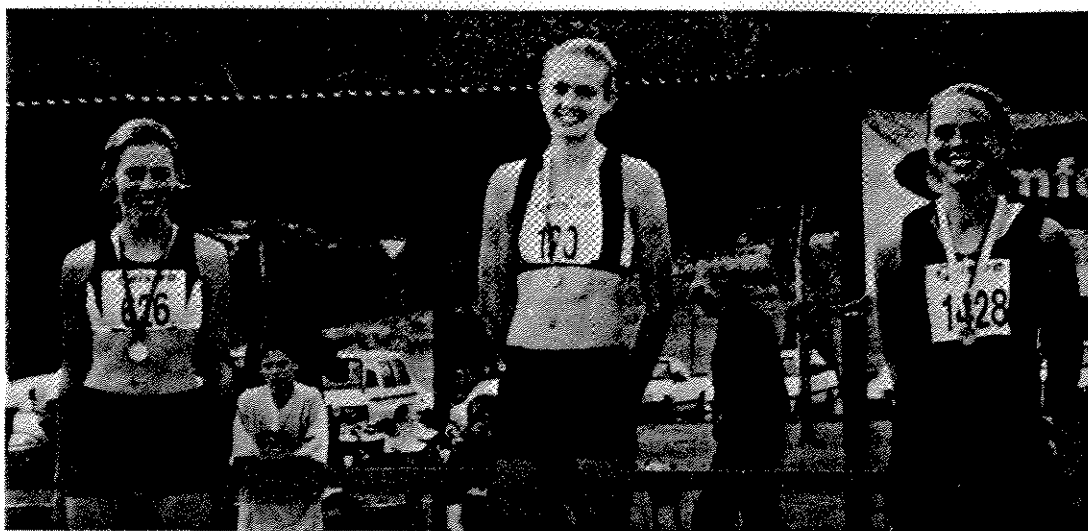

Comments on Annual Financial Statements by Dennis Jolliffe

Over the past five years, the Club's funds have fluctuated as follows -

In 2001-2002 Club Funds fell by \$893.77. This was partly due to registration receipts being significantly lower than payments to Athletics NSW for registrations, insurance and affiliation fees. During the year the Club has pursued a policy of subsidized registrations for many talented athletes, and while it has been successful in terms of athletic performances including winning the Winter Premiership, it has also come at a cost. For 2002-2003, the Executive is examining closely the number and amounts assisted in subsidized registrations. Also, cross country race fees have been increased to assist in balancing revenues against expenditures. During the year the Club purchased Life Membership and Merit Award badges to provide for future awards over the next decade. Although this has been a large expenditure this year, it is cheaper to make a bulk purchase than to order badges as required during a year. The other drain on Club Funds in 2001-2002 is reflected in the purchase of equipment, including an urgently needed Printer Stopwatch and tent.

The Club has received a forward grant of \$6,000 from Rockdale City Council towards the cost of a Community Fun Run to be held on 19 May 2002. This has been included in Cross Country income, and has also inflated the Club's bank balance.

The Club contributed \$1,312 to individual athletes and also paid \$1,057 in State Championship relay entry fees in 2001-2002. Teams fund revenue consisted of fund raising activities such as meat tasting, raffles, Club dinners and supply of

officials for the Half Marathon and City to Surf Events. This has been possible only through the efforts of Club supporters and members who have willingly assisted in this and other fund raising efforts. Particular thanks to Kay Culkin in this regard.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Club members who have provided assistance to me as Treasurer. Alan Staples, as Race Secretary, Coral and Albert Ferraro as Registrars, and Tom Richards who has handled Club Uniform purchases and sales have been of great help.

Once again, Michael Hanrahan has acted as honorary auditor. Michael who is a former Club member has been extremely diligent in his duties and his contribution is appreciated very much.

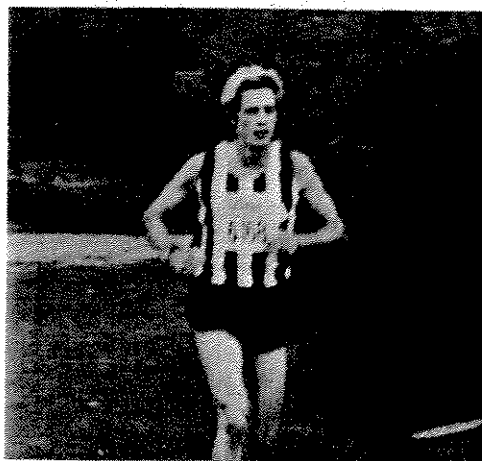

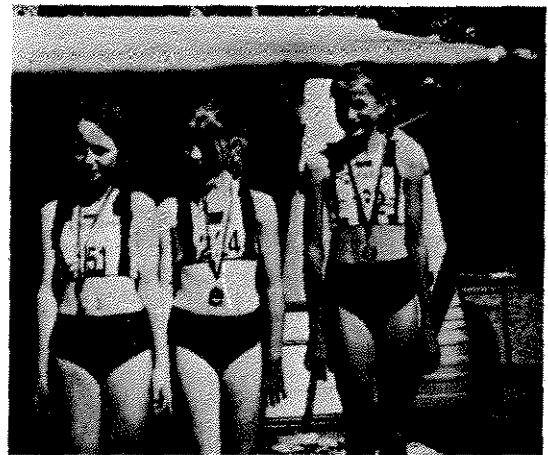
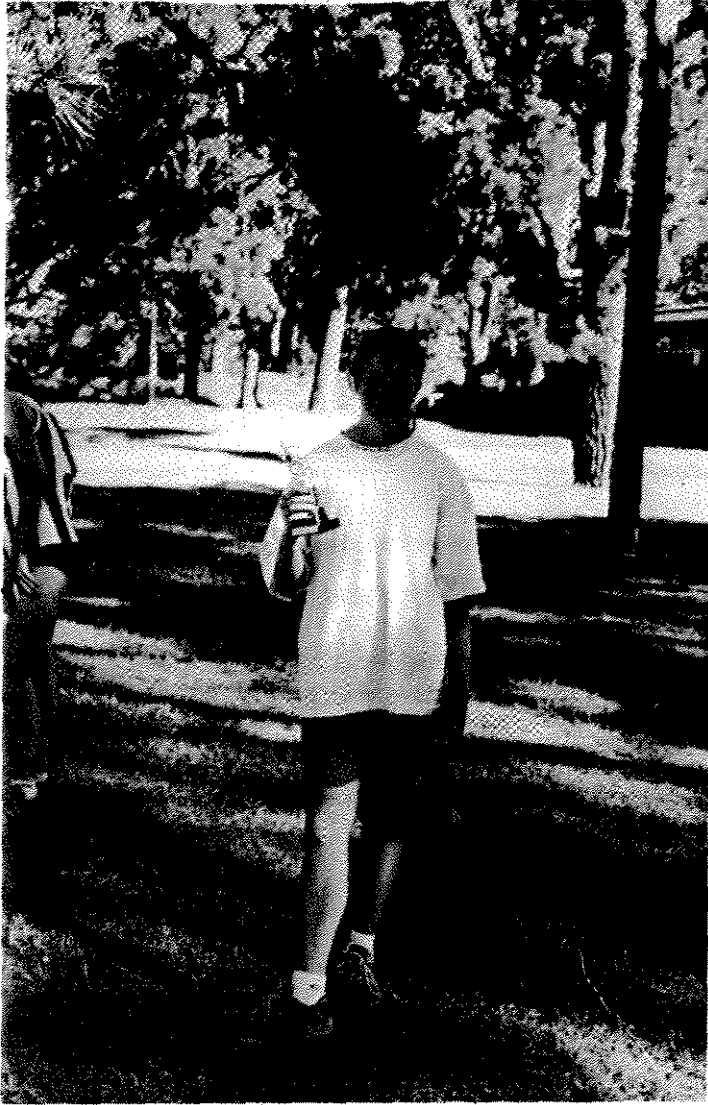
We report that we have examined the Income and Expenditure Statement of the St George District Athletic Club Inc for the year ended 31 March 2002.

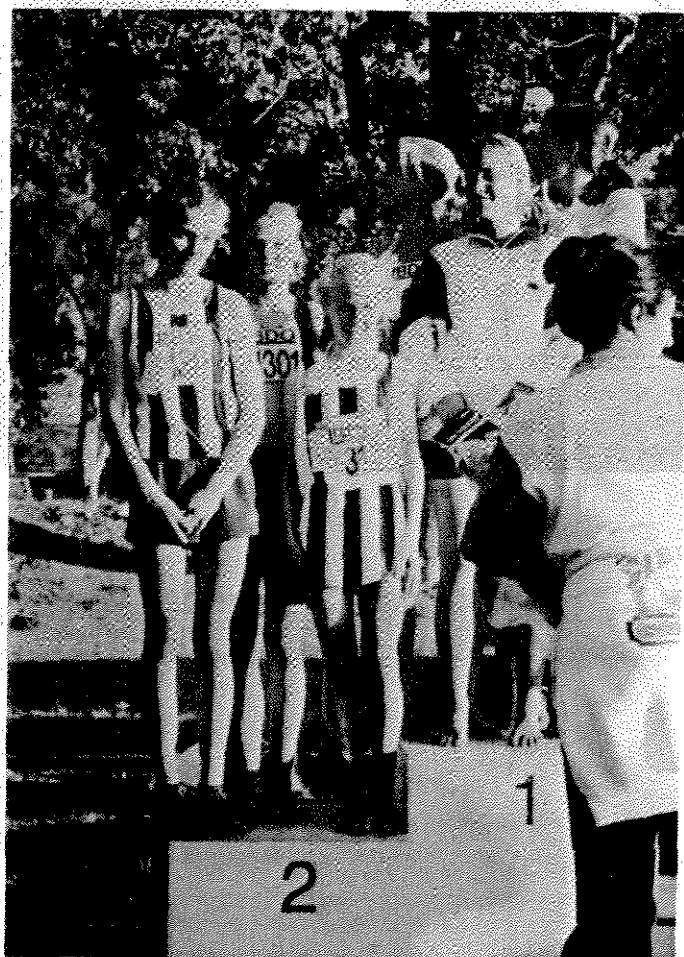

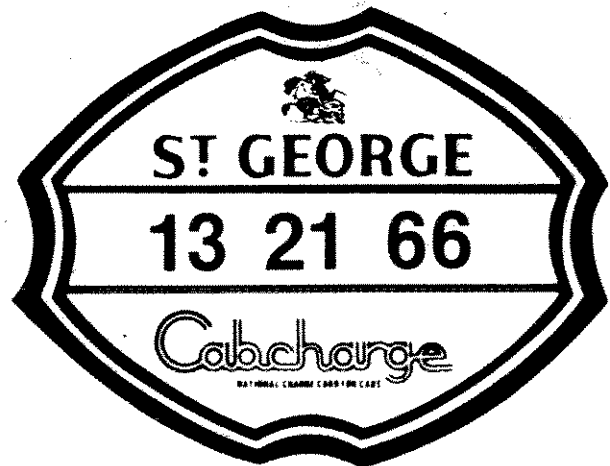
