2011 /2012 Track and Field Report Kim Delaney

It has been another outstanding year for our SGDAC track and field competitors.

Ben St Lawrence has now been selected for the Australian Olympic Track & Field team for the 2012 London Olympics. Ben was the 1st Australian in the men's Zatopek 10k last December, which gave Ben his second 10,000m title in a row, and this being an Olympic trial event, it placed him well for later inclusion into team. He is now set to become our seventh club member to represent his country.

Previous SGDAC Olympians include Ernest Austen 1924, Basil Dickinson 1936, and Claude Smeal 1952. Albie Thomas competed in three successive Olympics in 1956, 1960, and 1964. Graeme Rootham competed in 1972, Anne Manning in 1996, and Daniel Batman in the Sydney 2000 Olympics.

Others members who were close to this highest accolade after placing at the National titles this year, were Belinda Martin who placed third in the 5000m, and Bridey Delaney who placed second in the 1500m at nationals, and placed third in the 1500m at the Olympic trials. Nicole Harris performed tremendously, placing herself in third position for the Women's Shot Put Ambulant TF20, where she set herself well in contention for a position in the 2012 Australian Paralympics team. Our juniors this year have once again added more glory to our clubs wonderful history of achievements. Grace Robinson won three National titles this season, in the U15 discus & shot put at the Junior Championships and the U14 Australian All schools Shot put title. While Pita Toamotu claimed the U14 junior discus title, and placed second in the U14 shot-put. Furthermore, Matthew Rees claimed the U16 javelin junior title.

Shining a bright light from within our vets we had more success. Robyn Basman claimed 5 national titles at the Australian Masters Championships, setting two new state veterans records in the 1500m and 5000m, and one new Australian veteran record in the 3000m. Belinda Martin's time of 9:18.51 set a new Australian Masters 35+ 3000m record. Additionally, our women's 160+ 1500m relay team members Suzanne Harrington, Robyn Basman, Karen Stanley and Belinda Martin, set a new meet record at the state relays.

A quick summary of results during the 2011/2012 T&F season include: State Relays - 3 gold medal teams and 5 silver medal teams. Over the whole season our members picked up 73 medals in total. Eleven new club records were made, one new relay team meet record, five state age veteran records, with two of these also new Australian master's records. With such tremendous club spirit in place, which has already been well grounded by the efforts of our past members, champions, coaches and executives, the future of our club looks in very good stead. This SGDAC proud tradition will keep marching on via our current member's efforts, and the wonderful support of our friends and families. We can look confidently ahead to know that we will be applauding and cheering many more successes to come. Big thanks to you all.

Robert Nash Trophy (Most Improved Senior Athlete) – Suzanne Harrington. Suzanne has proven that through will, consistency, and hard work, great results will follow. Running in her first ½ marathon recently in Sydney she placed in the top 10 women's places. Comments on Annual Financial Statements by Dennis Jolliffe

Over the past five years, the Club's funds have moved as follows -

In the two years 2010-11 and 2011-12, Club Funds fell by \$6,354.66. This is the most significant drop in Club Funds over two successive years since I have been Treasurer.

Although the Club is protected from financial difficulties with our Term Deposit holdings that have an attractive rate of interest, we should look carefully at the reasons for this fall in funds. Registration fees collected have fallen short of payments to Athletics NSW for registrations and affiliation fees in 2011-12 by \$4,357. The Club subsidises elite and promising young athletes as well as athletes 14 years and under. These subsidies account for most of this shortfall.

To assist in making these registration subsidies and helping members compete in Australian Championships and other significant events, our Club is reliant on various Fund Raising activities such as supplying officials for the City to Surf and half marathon, organizing the Christmas Mile event, organizing the State Novice day on behalf of Athletics NSW, and participating in the Bed Racing competition. Our Club President Albie Thomas has been actively involved with all of these events, and his support is gratefully acknowledged.

Administrative expenses have also increased. For example, a few years ago our annual report was printed free of charge. Now, the Club has to pay to have the reports printed, resulting in a bill of \$585; this is a significant part of \$705 for expenditure on printing, postage and stationery. Costs associated with one of our main fund raising activities State Novice Day, have also increased.

It is obvious that fund raising activities have not been able to fully support our expenditures. The Club has some choices – to raise registration fees to be more in line with other Clubs; increase our fund raising activities with the support of all members; to continue to run down our reserves; or undertake a mixture of all three of these options.

Treasurer's Report - con't

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Club members who have provided assistance to me as Treasurer. Alan Staples, as Race Secretary, Rory McRae as Registrar, and Lyn Delaney who has handled Club Uniform purchases and sales, have been of great help.

Once again, Michael Hanrahan has acted as honorary auditor. Michael who was a former Club member but has now renewed his membership has been extremely diligent in his duties and his contribution is appreciated very much.

Changes from time to time to the fee structure to register members with Athletics NSW have resulted in inappropriate comparisons over time, and the best basis for comparisons between years is to be made by age groupings.

For 2008-09 and earlier years, figures in this report are for the twelve months ending 31st March. From 2009-10 onwards, figures are shown for the 12 months ending 30th September.

In 2010-11 Club member numbers increased by 12, and by 53 over the past three years. This increase reflects the policy of our Club in subsidising registrations for athletes 14 years and under, where numbers of members in these age groups have increased by 40 . During 2010-11, the Club received 70 new members and had 153 renewals, compared to 68 new members and 144 renewals for the previous year. Details of 2010-11 new and renewal members are shown below, indicating a higher retention rate across teenagers and older members –
