Novice Cross Country.

A. BLYTH CHAMPION.

TEAMS RACE TO ST. GEORGE.

As a result of the New South Wales Amateur Athletic Association deciding that in view of the unsatisfactory results of the five miles' novice cross-country championship, the race should be re-run, the event for the second time was promoted by the East Sydney Club on Saturday. A. Blyth, of St. George, won the individual title, and his club secured the teams' race.

It was the 16th race for the title, and in the earlier run, on June 16, W. J. Hyland, of East Sydney Club, gained the individual honours, after a close race with S. R. Hesketh, of Western Suburbs, and the teams event resulted in an easy victory for Western Suburbs. On Saturday there was a marked change in individual and team results.

Thirty-five of the original runners started from Bondi Beach, and the championship was decided in rain over a heavy course. Hesketh early assumed the lead. Running barefooted, he passed into Military-road, in advance of N. Gillard, E. L. Hunter, W. J. Hyland, and T. McAlister. In Brighton Boulevarde the Western Suburbs man held his advantage from Hyland and Creasy, followed by McAlister. Hesketh was still in front after traversing the beach for the second time, but in Military-road was passed by Blyth, then Hunter, Gillard, and McAlister followed at intervals. The St. George man moved away from Hesketh towards the beach, and won by 100 vards, with Gillard a close third. The time, 29m 48s, indicates that the distance was much closer to the prescribed five miles Although the four Western Suburbs runners finished than on the previous occasion,

Although the four Western Suburbs runners finished with the last man in 14th place, and St. George's fourth representative was 19th, the total points gave the latter club victory in the teams race by four points, the figures being 29-33, due to the prominent positions occupied by the two leading St. George men.

Two sealed handicaps were decided in conjunction with the championship, one on the original starts, and the second handicapped on form displayed since June

16, in open competition.

Blyth is a youthful runner, who has shown promising form on the track. He holds the middle distance championships of the St. George Club, and finished second in the one mile race for the State title last March. In the previous novice championship he occupied third place, but as on that occasion the race was at least half a mile short, Blyth showed that he was suited by the longer distance, as he did not assume the lead until reaching the last mile.
